General Explanation: Activities undertaken on behalf of the foreign principal include advising the client on the language of a potential Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the Ministry of Tourism for the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and 30 foreign government agencies, including in the United States. The purpose of the MOU is to establish collaboration on the formation of a Sustainable Tourism Global Center, including the participation of individuals to provide technical expertise on subjects of Climate and Tourism covered by the center, and on the potential governance structure of the Center itself, which they wish to establish as a multi-national multi stakeholder organization which would be governed under international law. The registrant also advised the foreign principal on potential events and timing for a signing of the MOU.
