Pekao Trading Corporation sells in the United States standard parcels, groups or units of foodstuffs and merchandise which are delivered to persons resident in Poland from Polish sources of supply through Bank Polska Kasa Opieki, S.A. Pekao makes payment to the Bank at agreed prices for each parcel. Sales in the United States are made both directly and through dealers who are independent contractors.

¹The term "foreign principal" includes, in addition to those defined in section 1(b) of the Act, an individual or organization any of whose activities are directly or indirectly supervised, directed, controlled, financed, or subsidized in whole or in major part by a foreign government, foreign political party, foreign organization or foreign individual. 


