Pekao Trading Corporation sells in the United States standard parcels, groups or units of foodstuffs and merchandise, which are delivered to persons resident in Poland from Polish sources of supply, through Bank Polska Kasa Opieki S.A. "For Selection" orders give the recipients the opportunity of obtaining the merchandise they most desire, by receiving merchandise certificates, which enable them to choose the most wanted articles at their own convenience. Pekao Trading Corporation makes payment to the Bank at agreed prices for each parcel. Sales in the United States are made both directly and through dealers who are independent contractors. Also acted as good will intermediary for individuals in transmitting funds that were sent to us for the Polish Olympic team and the Committee for the Restoration of the Castle in Warsaw. Importers and sellers of Polish coins.

Pekao Trading Corporation has been licensed by the New York State Banking Department since October 24, 1972 as a Transmitter of Funds.
