The New Testament Church versus Denomi**national doctrines** (starts July 13). What some teach compared with the church Jesus built and bought. Taught by Greg Nash.



BE THE CHURCH: SALT AND LIGHT

Matthew 5:13-16

INTRODUCTION:

- 1. Following the beatitudes, Jesus tells his audience that they are like salt and light.
- 2. He wanted them to live in such a way that they would make the most impact on the world
- 3. He challenged them to reflect the good news of the kingdom by imitating its King.

DISCUSSION:

"SALT OF THE EARTH" (vs. 13)

- and a. Salt flavors food, Christians flavor the world in which they live.
- b. Salt preserves food, Christians preserve (protect, keep, alive, save) this world in which they live.
- c. Salt purifies water.
- d. The Greeks believed that salt had a divine quality about it, and the Romans often paid their soldiers with it.
- e. Salt was also used as an ancient fertilizer (Luke 14:34-35).

"LIGHT OF THE WORLD" (vss. 14-15)

A. Light

- a. In scripture, light is often a symbol of truth, purity, and righteousness.
- b. "Darkness," in contrast, is a symbol of ignorance and evil.

and

- c. In the Old Testament God asked Israel to be a light to the Gentile nations (Isa. 42:6; 49:6).
- d. Jesus was the light of man (John 1:1-10; John 8:12; 9:5).
- e. Jesus said that His followers are the light of the world (Phil. 2:15).
- f. In other words, Christians are to reflect the light of their master.

INFLUENCE THAT GLORIFIES GOD (vs. 16)

- A. Your influence is not about drawing attention to yourself but pointing people to God.
- B. When we live lives of kindness, integrity, compassion, and courage, the world sees and God is glorified!
- C. Salt that flavors and light that shines will cause others to ask, "what's different about you?" And that's your open door to share the gospel.
