- A. James tells us several important points as we try to apply the previous verses:
 - a. Human anger does not accomplish God's righteousness (vs. 20).
 - 1. We should be slow to anger (vs. 19).
 - 2. Be angry and sin not (Eph. 4:26).
 - b. Rid ourselves of moral filth and evil (vs. 21).
 - c. Humbly receive the Word which can save us (vs. 21).
 d. We MUST be doers or the Word and not just hearers (vs. 23).
 - e. Our religion is useless if we do not control our tongue (vs. 26).
