THESIS: To urge God's people to check their concept of Christianity.

INTRODUCTION:

- If vigilance is the price of liberty, examination and rededication are necessary to Christianity.
- Some passages give us a condensed statement of Christianity: such is true of 1 Timothy 1:5.
- It is Important to occasionally take a look at Christianity.
 - Constantly challenged by false doctrine (**1 Tim. 1:3**).
 - Often lost under cloud of “theological nit-picking” (**1 Tim. 1:4**).
