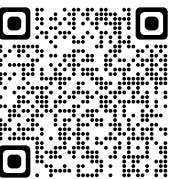

(Hebrews 13:5-7, 17)

INTRODUCTION:

1. A key word when thinking of character is “_____.”
 - A. The entire situation between God & Satan was over Job’s integrity (2:3).
 - B. Mrs. Job questioned him about it (2:8).
2. You could sum up the life of Jesus with the word “integrity” (Acts 10:38).
 - A. At home and in the church integrity is sometimes the missing ingredient.
 - B. Church problems are most often lack of integrity among some members.
 - C. You may not always see integrity, but you will always see when it is not there.
3. We continue the dream that our children will be known by the content of their character.
