(Hebrews 13:1-7, 17)

INTRODUCTION:

- As you go through life will you –
A. Remember your leaders?
B. Reflect on the outcome of their lives and imitate their faith?
- I know that my primary joy is to follow Jesus – also our leaders in faith!
A. I will use a made-up word – “followship.”
B. Does my followship style help this congregation?
- Followers often mirror their leaders.
A. Weak leaders make weak followers & vice versa.
B. Bad leaders and bad followers can cause as much damage as false teaching.
- Jesus called people to be followers – “Follow me” (Matt. 4:19).
A. This is the mission of the Good Shepherd (Jn. 10:4).
B. Sheep are good at doing one thing – following.
- Half of what we are we are by imitation (1 Cor. 11:1).

A. _____ followers (1 Cor. 13:5).
1. Some like to be pampered, coddled & forever apologized to.
2. No one is to be an offense to another – but walk on eggshells?
B. _____ followers – can be very loving, but also unpredictable.
1. Cats are independent, unwilling to be trained & have a mind of their own.
2. Ever hear of a watch cat, sheep cat, seeing eye cat or one acknowledge its name?
3. Some brethren are untouchable, un-coachable, never grateful to leaders.
C. _____ or _____ followers (Psa. 32:9).
1. They have no understanding of what they need to do.
2. Do we have to be made to follow God? Constrained by discipline?
D. _____ follows – “Take a lickin’ and keep on tickin’.”
1. They are the ones who serve first rather than scream foul.
2. They are zealous (Tit. 2:14).
3. They are the diehards (Matt. 16:24).
