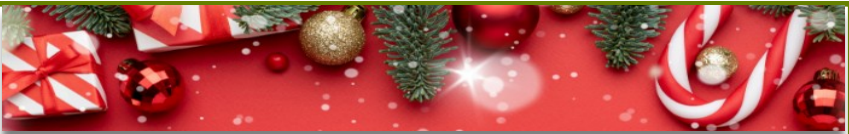


Calendar Events
