
RuPearl Sharpe lost her sister, Frankie Griffin, last Monday.

**DISCUSSION:****I. BE AN EXAMPLE IN YOUR**

A. Our words reveal our \_\_\_\_\_ (Luke 6:45).

a. Words can heal or wound (Prov. 18:21).

A. Our life must match our message - We teach more by how we live than by what we say.

**B. Conduct includes**

**Key thought:** *The greatest sermon some people will ever hear is the one you live.***III. BE AN EXAMPLE IN****A. In**

a. Applies to thoughts, motives, desires, relationships.

b. Purity says: “I belong to Christ — in every area of life.”

c. In a world of compromise, purity shines brightly.

**CONCLUSION:**

1. Paul's message to Timothy is God's message to us:

• You don't need a title - You don't need status - You don't need age or experience

2. You just need **Christlike character**.3. **Be an example:** In your **words** - In your **conduct** - In your **love** - In your **faith** - In your **purity**

4. Live in such a way that others see Christ in you!
