

Ephesians 4:11–16; 29–32

- I. _____ (1 Corinthians 1:10–13)
 - A. **Division redirects loyalty away from** _____.
 - B. Division is dangerous because it feels justified. Everyone thinks they are defending something important. But the question is not, “Am I right?” The question is, “Is this building up the body?”
 - C. **Division drains strength from the** _____.
 - a. A divided church may still meet, but it cannot move forward effectively.
 - b. The enemy does not always destroy from the outside — sometimes he distracts from the inside. - D. **Key Statement:** Division doesn’t just slow the work — it stops the work.
