

INTENTIONAL EDIFICATION

1 Thessalonians 5:11 – *Therefore, comfort each other and edify one another, just as you also are doing.*

E -

- **1 Corinthians 11:1** – *“Imitate me, just as I also imitate Christ.”*
- **Matthew 5:16** – *“Let your light so shine before men...”*
- **John 13:34-35** – *“As I have loved you, so you must love one another...”*

D -

- **INDIVIDUALLY:**
 - **Hebrews 5:14** – *“Solid food belongs to those who are of full age... trained...”*
 - **1 Timothy 4:7** – *“But reject profane and old wives’ fables, and exercise yourself toward godliness.”*
- **TOGETHER:**
 - **Hebrews 10:24** - *And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works,*
 - We are not meant to grow alone.
 - A single coal removed from the fire will grow cold - but placed back among others, it burns bright again.

I -

- **Philippians 2:4** – *“Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others.*
- **Galatians 6:2** – *“Bear one another’s burdens and so fulfill the law of Christ.”*
 - A gardener does not plant seeds and walk away forever. He waters, checks, nurtures, and protects. Growth requires investment.

F -

- **2 Timothy 4:7-8** - *⁷ I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. ⁸ Finally, there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will give to me on that Day, and not to me only but also to all who have loved His appearing.*
 - A coach does not train athletes just to make them feel good—he trains them to win. In the same way, we are helping one another reach heaven (which is true success!).
 - Edification is about **heaven-focused growth**, not temporary relief.

Y -

- **1 Thessalonians 2:8** – *“We cared so much for you that we were pleased to share with you not only the gospel of God but also our own lives, because you had become dear to us.”*
- **Romans 12:15** – *“Rejoice with those who rejoice; weep with those who weep.”*
 - A parent does not invest in a child out of duty alone—but out of deep love and desire to see them grow.
 - When you truly care, edification becomes natural—not forced.
