

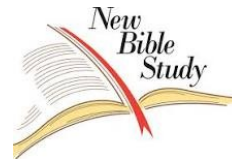

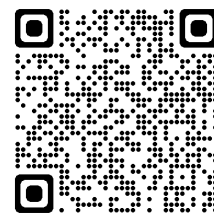

Hosea 4:6

- I. **THE TRAGEDY OF** _____
 - A. "My people are destroyed..." (vs. 6).
 - B. **Ignorance Leads to** _____
 - a. Without knowledge, we cannot grow
 - b. Ephesians 4:14 - "tossed to and fro... by every wind of doctrine"
 - C. **Ignorance Leads to** _____
 - a. You cannot obey what you do not know.
 - b. Psalm 119:11 - "Your word I have hidden in my heart, that I might not sin..."
 - D. **Ignorance Leads to** _____
 - a. Broken homes - Weak churches - Shallow faith.
 - b. This is not accidental—it is the result of **neglecting God's Word**.
- II. **THE CAUSE:** _____ **OF** _____
 - A. "...because you have rejected knowledge..." (vs. 6).
 - B. **Not a Lack of** _____
 - a. They had priests - They had the Law - They had opportunities
 - b. Today: We have Bibles everywhere. Sermons, podcasts, classes, etc...
 - C. **A Lack of** _____
 - a. We crave entertainment more than truth. We scroll more than we study.
 - b. 2 Timothy 4:3 - "They will not endure sound doctrine..."
 - C. **A Lack of** _____
 - a. We say: "I don't have time to study"
 - b. But we always have time for: TV, Phones, Hobbies, etc...
 - c. The issue is not time...The issue is **value**.
- III. **THE** _____ **OF** _____ **GOD'S WORD**
 - A. "...I also will reject you..." (vs. 6) This is one of the most sobering statements in Scripture.
 - B. **Loss of** _____
 - a. When we reject God's Word, we reject God Himself.
 - b. John 12:48 - "The word that I have spoken will judge him..."
 - C. **Loss of** _____ "...from being priest for me..." (vs. 6)
 - a. They lost their role.
 - b. A church without knowledge: Cannot teach, cannot evangelize, cannot build.
 - D. **Loss of Future** _____
 - a. "...I will also forget your children." (vs. 6).
 - b. We are always **one generation away from spiritual collapse**.
- IV. **THE SOLUTION:** _____ **TO** _____
 - A. If destruction comes from lack of knowledge, then life comes from **knowing God's Word**.
 - B. **Develop a** _____ **for** _____
 - a. Matt. 5:6 - "Blessed are those who hunger and thirst..."
 - C. **Commit to** _____
 - a. 2 Timothy 2:15 - "Be diligent to present yourself approved..."
 - b. Not casual reading—**intentional study**.
 - D. _____ **What You** _____
 - a. James 1:22 - "Be doers of the word, and not hearers only..."
 - b. Knowledge alone is not enough - It must become **transformation**.
 - E. _____ **Others** (2 Timothy 2:2)
 - a. Parents teach children - Christians teach others.
 - b. We don't just learn—we **pass it on**.
