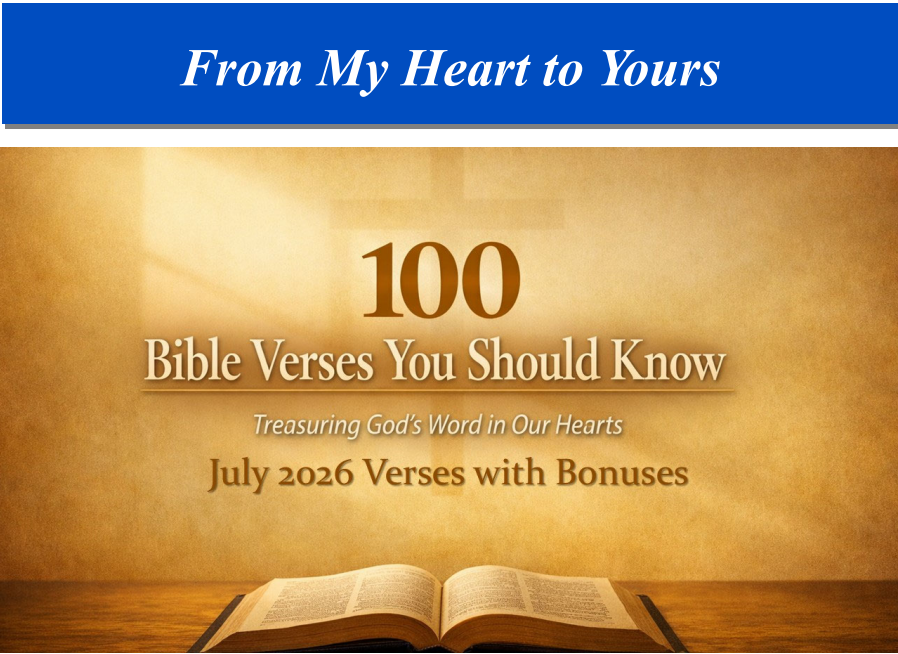




1. Choose your Bible translation.

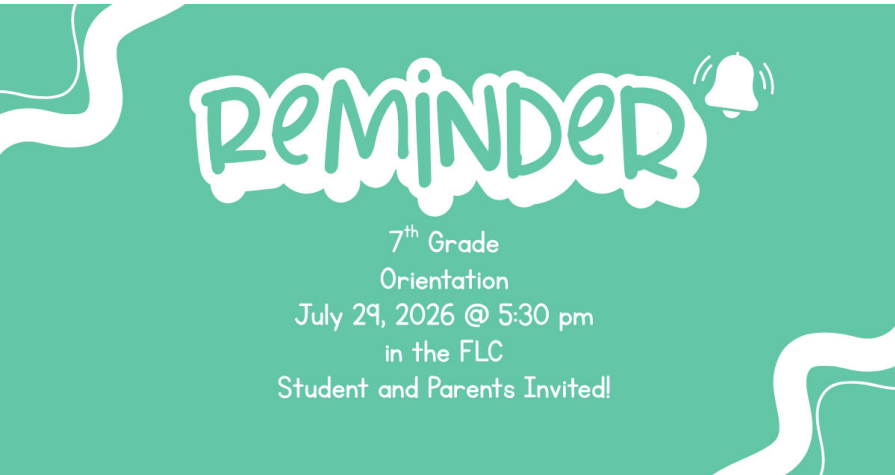
