We are now preparing the plans for Phase 2, which will include the 1st floor of the Adult Education building and current office complex.

Phase 2 will require interim locations of our church offices over to the new Mission Center, on the corner of Monticello St. and 2nd Street. We have completed our relocation and are open for business at our temporary location. We will maintain the normal office hours as in the past: Monday - Friday, 8:30a.m.-4:00p.m.

Also, some Sunday School classes and the conference room will be relocated during Phase 2 on a temporary basis. A plan for interim locations for those Sunday School classes that are affected has been presented to those Sunday School teachers. I ask all of us to remember the adage – “Blessed are the flexible, they will survive.” Let’s work together in the spirit of Christ.

Thank you for your generous, sacrificial and faithful giving to our Building on Faith campaign. Your gifts to the building fund during construction reduces the debt that may have to be financed. Less debt, less charged interest = more freedom for future ministry.

Men of Honest Report: A deacon’s reputation should be beyond reproach. **Acts 6:3**

A deacon should think God’s thoughts and live by God’s principles, taken from God’s Word. It should be obvious that Christ lives in him. **Acts 6:3**

Not Greedy of Filthy Lucre: A deacon shall not pursue dishonest gain. **1 Timothy 3:8**

A Man of Dignity: A deacon should do the Lord’s work in sincerity and dedication. He should be a man worthy of respect. **1 Timothy 3:8**

A Man Holding to the Faith with a Clear Conscience: A deacon should be an earnest follower of Christ, sound in his faith. **1 Timothy 3:9**

A Man Tested and Proven, Beyond Reproach: A deacon should be a man seasoned in the faith, spiritually mature, not a new Christian. He should be a tither and a man given to sharing his faith. He should be tested in his Sunday School, Discipleship Training, Prayer Meeting and church attendance. **1 Timothy 3:10**

Husband of Only One Wife: Only males shall be eligible for the office of deacon. A deacon shall not have been divorced. **1 Timothy 3:10**

Good Managers of Their Children and Own Households: He should be an exemplary head of his household. His wife should be kindly disposed toward the church and his children raised in the wisdom of God. **1 Timothy 3:12**

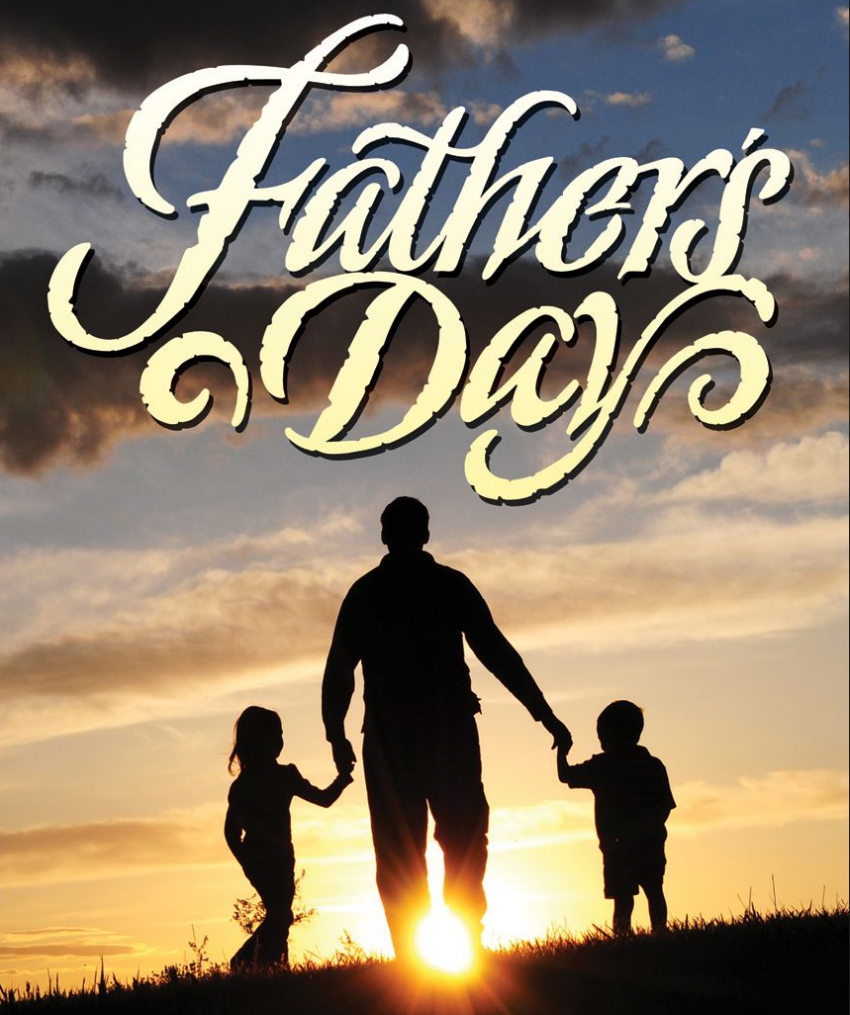
