Let’s look ahead for a moment – July will have some special events and one of those will be Sunday, July 19th in our 10:45a.m. service – Daniel Crews in Concert. The July Calendar will also be mailed soon, so look for the other special services in that month.

Our Building on Faith phase 1 is nearing the end – ceiling tile is installed, painting has begun and floors will be laid soon. According to our Executive Building Committee and Paul Jackson and Son building contractor, this phase should be completed near the middle of July. We are now preparing the plans for Phase 2, which will include the first floor of the Adult Education building and current office complex.

Phase 2 will require interim locations of our church offices over to the new Mission Center, on the corner of Monticello St. and 2nd Street. We have completed our relocation and are open for business at our temporary location. We will maintain the normal office hours as in the past: Monday - Friday, 8:30a.m.-4:00 p.m.

Also, some Sunday School classes and the conference room will be relocated during Phase 2 on a temporary basis. A plan for interim locations for those Sunday School classes that are affected has been presented to those Sunday School teachers. I ask all of us to remember the adage – “Blessed are the flexible, they will survive.” Let’s work together in the spirit of Christ.

Thank you for your generous, sacrificial and faithful giving to our Building on Faith campaign. Your gifts to the building fund during construction reduces the debt that may have to be financed. Less debt, less charged interest = more freedom for future ministry.
