1 John 2:15

The world's system is deeply entrenched in rebellion, one that exalts human pride, glorifies selfishness and encourages independence from God. And here is the crucial point: this world system operates under Satan's influence.

1 John 5:19

As a citizen of both earth and heaven, our responsibility is to advance God's values and purposes whenever possible—including through our vote—reflecting His truth in the decisions we make.

1 John 2:16

The values of this world system are fundamentally incompatible with the values of God's kingdom.
