### 5 PRIORITIES FOR 2025:

- 50 baptisms: Lives changed by the gospel
- 100 new families: Building a community of faith
- 150 new people in our discipleship pipeline
- Redesign our children’s area
- Improve all of our worship environments through technology

### Big Idea:

\_\_\_\_\_ fuels vision, and vision requires action.

### 1. Vision Starts with a \_\_\_\_\_ (Nehemiah 2:1-5)

**Proverbs 21:1** “The king’s heart is a stream of water in the hand of the Lord; he turns it wherever he will.”

If God’s reputation matters to us, we will live with an \_\_\_\_\_ to make His name known to the world.
