AO HOUSE NEWS

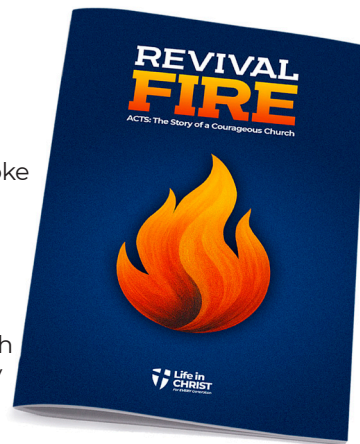
