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Council Public Input

- Executive order 151 sets policy for CityLink, CityLink publishes council meetings
- City ordinance 30.015 "Addressing the council ..."
- First amendment trumps both
- "Congress shall make no law ... abridging the freedom of speech"

First Amendment Rights

- “People have greater rights to free speech when it's being conducted in a public forum. Specifically, the government can impose reasonable time, place, and manner restrictions on speech in both public and non-public forums, but has limited ability to impose content-based restrictions on traditional or designated public forums.”
- Prohibition against “electronic” public input may be unconstitutional.

- “In the first such ruling by a court of appeals, the justices found that the First Amendment right to Free Speech protects negative commentators, even on social media platforms, such as Facebook.”
