Need a line

- Hard to see separation between road, trail
- Paint a yellow line



Straighten some bends

Should be safer

- Windy, narrow underpass hard to use
- Pave railroad crossing



Ravines need sediment dam

- Ravines spill sediment on trail during rain
- Dam to trap sediment, release water



Dirt piles
