- Hard to talk to your boss' boss
- Police, guns, principals all intimidating
- School (and work!) can already feel like prison on a beautiful spring day

Student Viewpoint

- Needs to be determined
- Let's take a survey
- Do you like having police in your school?
- Do you feel safer with police in school?
- Are you intimidated with police in school?
- Would it help if school cops did not carry weapons?
- How can police connect with students?

Recommendations

- Ask students how they feel
- Emphasize mental health & social welfare over law enforcement
- Continue, modify, or stop having police in schools
