
#### Lane Width

- Varies from 9' to 15'
- Interstate lanes are 12' wide
- City lanes are often 10' wide
- Narrower lanes slow vehicle traffic
- Red light timing bigger limit to throughput

#### The Issue

- There is diagonal parking on Phillips Avenue
- Provides more parking, less space for traffic
- Slower traffic encourages pedestrians
- Better for business
- Some pickup trucks stick out
- Uncomfortable for drivers
- Driving line still usually 10' wide
- Short parking stalls resulted in 8' 3" driving lane too narrow – not safe



## Short Parking Spot




#### Short Spot (Empty)
