

Now that we have your attention, it is time to encourage a young person you may know who is interested in Normande cattle and would like to get a start in developing their herd of Normandes. Contact your county 4-H extension agent or your local high school ag instructor and tell them about this program.

Pictured to the left is Courtney Jenkins of Bolivar, MO, with the Normande heifer calf she received as winner of the 2016 NANA Youth Junior Heifer Program. If you are 12-17 years old, are a member of 4-H or FFA, and do not currently own a Normande animal you are eligible to enter the program. If you are chosen the

winner you will be awarded the ownership of a Normande heifer at the National Normande Show on September 9, 2017.

Prior to the 2017 NANA National Show the winner will be chosen and he/she will have the privilege of taking home a registered Normande heifer to raise and show. The ownership of the heifer will be transferred to their name. To enter the program a young person must submit signed agreements and an essay (no more than 425 words) titled "Why I Want To Own A Normande Heifer". The NANA Junior Heifer Program rules, application, and stipulations are below. Applications must be submitted to the

NANA office by **07-31-17**, and the winner will be expected to pick up their heifer at the National Show in Mineral Point, WI, on September 9, 2017. If applicants have any questions please call the NANA office (608-943-6091 or 800-573-6254).

PURPOSE AND GENERAL INFORMATION: The purpose of this contest is to encourage the growth and development of Normande Cattle breeders through 4-H and FFA projects and programs.

Through this program one registered Normande Beef **or** one Normande Dairy heifer calf will be awarded to a winning applicant. The winning applicant will also be awarded one year of free membership to NANA as a Junior Member. Current NANA Junior Members who do not presently own any Normande cattle are eligible to participate. A contestant can win only one heifer during their 4-H or FFA career. Once a contestant is awarded a heifer they are not eligible to apply again. Applicants not chosen to receive a heifer in the

year they apply are eligible to apply in another year, as long as the age requirements are met.

Applicants can be male or female, and **must** be 12-17 years of age. We encourage the person to be active in either 4-H or FFA. The winner of the heifer **must** compete in at least two cattle shows per year. The two cattle shows **must** include their local county fair and the annual National Normande Show. The winner is encouraged to show in other cattle shows, but it is not required beyond the two specified shows. Applicants essay **must** be in their handwriting and **must** be accompanied by a completed Parental Consent Form.

Each applicant's entry will be judged on the applicant's need for help in getting started with Normande cattle, neatness and completeness of the application and essay, ability to provide a good home for the calf, and the desire of the applicant as expressed in his or her essay. The title of the essay will be **"Why I Want to Own a Normande Heifer."** The essay **shall not** exceed 425 words. To apply simply use the entry form below. If additional forms are needed you can make additional copies, but copies must not be altered in any way from the application below. All applications **must be submitted to the NANA office and be post marked no later than July 31, 2017.**

WHAT IS REQUIRED OF THE WINNING APPLICANT:

1. Adequate facilities for the care of the heifer **must** be provided.
2. The responsibility for the daily care of the heifer **must** be accepted by the recipient and his/her family.
3. The recipient and his/her family **must** be capable of handling all expenses (veterinary, breeding, feed, housing, transportation, etc) that occur with ownership of an animal.

4. The recipient **must** show his/her heifer for two years at their local county fair and the National Normande Show.
5. The recipient **must** breed his/her heifer to a registered Normande bull.
6. The recipient **must** register their heifer's first calf with NANA if the calf is a heifer.
7. The recipient **must** be open to a NANA representative checking on the welfare of the heifer if requested by NANA.
8. The recipient **must** submit photos and a yearly summary of their activities with the heifer for two years. The photos and summary may be used in NANA.s newsletter.
9. The recipient **must** be willing to promote the Normande breed and this program to others.
10. The recipient and his/her family **must** be willing to commit themselves to the two year length of this program.
11. The recipient is encouraged to pay the dues for NANA membership in the second year of the program.
12. NANA reserves the right to reclaim the animal if deemed necessary due to the recipient not complying with the above requirements.

ST. CROIX VALLEY BULL TEST SALE RESULTS

Three performance tested Normande bulls sold in the St. Valley Bull Test Sale for an average of \$2300.00 on April 15, 2017. The 2017 SCVBT sale prices reflected the down turn in cattle prices the beef industry has been experiencing over the past year. The continued expansion of the national beef cow herd has had its anticipated negative affect on cattle prices.



Topping the sale of Normande bulls was Crick Ridge Dunkin Donut, a son of Circle D Foolerman Zoland. Bred by Jeff and Nona Bock of River Falls, WI, he brought a price of \$2400.00 and was purchased by Normande breeder Wallace Brockhoff of Linwood, KS. Dunkin Donut had an average daily gain of 3.03 pounds during the test. His pre-sale ultra sound showed he had .14 inch of external fat at the 12th rib; a rib eye of 18.0 square inches; and 2.58% of inter muscular fat

Circle D Impact Demand 7D, a son of Circle D Rocket Impact 622P sold for \$2300.00. He was bred by Wayne and Lisa Dewey of Iowa Falls, IA and was purchased by an unknown buyer (At the time of publication.) from Iowa. Demand had an average daily gain of 3.71 pounds during the bull test. His pre-sale ultra sound revealed .16 inch of external fat at the 12th rib; a rib eye of 12.8 square inches; and 3.06% of inter muscular fat.



Another son of Circle D Foolerman Zoland, Crick Ridge Deputy Dawg, was purchased by Paul and Delores Moechnig of Lake City, MN for \$2200.00. Jeff and Nona Bock are the breeders of Deputy Dawg. Deputy Dawg had an average daily gain of 3.05 pounds during the test. His pre-sale ultra sound results showed he had .14 inch of inter muscular fat; a rib eye of 13.1 square inches; and 3.28% inter muscular fat.

After the untimely death of NANA's webmaster nearly one and a half years ago, our NANA website has languished with a serious lack of updates. At its April board of directors meeting the NANA board of directors approved hiring Webit, a website design and management company out of Souix Falls, SD, to re-create NANA's website and make it user friendly for the NANA office and members. The website already contains a fair amount of information and material, including profiles on the French bulls available through NANA Normande Solutions agreement with Evolution, a very large French AI Coop.

NANA NORMANDE SOLUTIONS

Because of some confusion among semen buyers about similar names and which business/person they represented the NANA Board of Directors and Evolution have agreed to change their agreement from Normand-E-Genetic Solutions to **NANA Normande Solutions**. Hopefully this name change will avoid any further confusion among those seeking to purchase Normande semen.

The NANA Board of Directors had been made aware folks were confused by three similar names of entities selling Normande semen and who was associated with which entity. To clarify who is who, please take note.

Normande Genetic Solutions is owned by Dr. Brian Toivola of Hibbing, MN. Up until a few years ago, Brian and his family bred and raised registered Normandes under the farm name of Spruce Grove Farm. They have bred many of the great animals of the breed. Brian was NANA's president for many years and his wife, Judy, was the registry secretary for many years as well. Normande Genetic Solutions has a large supply of semen from older Normande bulls.

Normande Genetics is related to Jerome Chateau of Minneapolis, MN. Jerome has been selling French Normande semen under that business name since the mid 1990's.

NANA Normande Solutions is the new name for NANA's agreement with Evolution, one of the world's largest AI Coops. Under this agreement, NANA is the exclusive merchandiser of French Normande semen from Evolution. The semen from Evolution is stored at Hawkeye Breeder's Service Inc. in Adel, IA. NANA Normande Solutions is able to ship semen anywhere in the United States. If someone is telling you otherwise, they are either ignorant of NANA Normande Solution's capabilities, or they are deliberately misrepresenting where NANA Normande Solutions can ship semen.

Evolution carries some of the world's top Normande genetics and is a leader in developing the best Normande bulls. They genomic and progeny test over 400 Normande bulls each year to maintain their leadership in genetic progression in the livestock industry.
