

Florida Amendment 4, Voting Rights Restoration for Felons

Convicted felons that want their voting rights restored, so they can start voting in the elections, must stop by their Supervisor of Elections Office and fill out an Application as a new voter. They must be in compliance with Amendment 4, having completed all of the terms of their sentence, including parole and probation. This Amendment does not apply to those convicted of murder or a sexual offense.
