

Care & Maintenance

When it comes to our handcrafted tile, just a little bit goes a long way. With the proper care, you can maintain the longevity and beauty of your Fireclay Tile installation for generations.

GENERAL CARE

- Prior to installation, make sure your Fireclay Tile is suited to the application.
- If a tile should crack, break, or come loose, it can be carefully removed and replaced from tile left over in your Attic Stock. We recommend hiring a qualified tile installer as it can be difficult to remove without damaging surrounding tiles.
- Always keep leftover tile, or as we call it, "attic stock" for add-ons and potential repairs.
- For grout maintenance, carefully read the manufacturer's label for additional instructions.

TILE CARE

Recommended Tools:

- Mild dishwashing soap with water and a clean rag or mop OR any neutral pH cleaner specified for tile
- · For any cleaning product, test a small amount on your tile to make sure it doesn't affect the glaze.
- Use cleaning products that don't contain phosphoric acid. Avoid cleansers that contain acids such as vinegar or lemon juice.
- Immediately clean any spills or stains.

GLASS CARE

Recommended Tools:

- Microfiber towels
- For routine cleaning use non-abrasive glass cleaners

BRICK CARE

Recommended Tools:

- Mild soap with water
- Minimal maintenance is required. Test any cleaners on an inconspicuous spot before use.
