The fee for the Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff includes, but is not limited to: Licensed and properly trained mortician(s) available twenty-four hours a day and each day of the calendar year to serve your family, arrangement conference with family or responsible party, arrangement of services selected, preparation and filing of necessary authorizations and permits, recording vital statistics, preparation and placement of obituary notices, staff assistance and coordination prior to, during, and following the funeral services selected with those providing other portions of the funeral. Also included in the fee are overhead expenses relative to our facility such as insurance, taxes, maintenance, utilities, administrative costs, and equipment.

The fee for the Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff will be added to the total costs of the funeral arrangements you select. A portion of this fee is already included in our charges for forwarding/receiving of remains, direct cremations and immediate burials.

#### **EMBALMING**

Embalming may be necessary, however, if certain funeral arrangements are selected, such as an event that allows for viewing of the body. If embalming is not requested, the right to choose an arrangement without embalming, such as direct cremation, immediate burial, or refrigeration/use of dry ice is available.

#### **CREMATION**

This fee is for the process needed to cremate human remains. Minnesota law does not require the purchase of a casket for cremation. A cremation container may be used. A cremation container is a combustible, closed container that encases the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or corrugated cardboard and into which human remains are placed prior to insertion into a cremation chamber for cremation. The containers we provide are corrugated cardboard. Please see our Cremation Container Price List for an itemized listing of the cremation containers and the alternative containers we offer.

Our charge for a Direct Cremation (without ceremony) includes a portion of the Basic Services of Funeral Director & Staff, utility vehicle (mileage fee beyond our standard 10 miles radius not included) transfer of human remains to the funeral home and eventually to the crematory, other preparation of the body and cremation of the human remains. If you want to arrange a cremation, you can use a basic alternative cremation container or viewing container. A cremation container is a combustible, closed container that encases the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or corrugated cardboard and into which human remains are placed prior to insertion into a cremation chamber for cremation. Please see our Cremation Container Price List for an itemized listing of the cremation containers we offer. Not included in the fee for direct cremation is the cost of an urn, creating an obituary, medical examiner fee and scheduling of any services or assistance with planning (including the cemetery).
