Butler Funeral Homes & Cremation Tribute Center—Springfield:

Located in downtown Springfield, Butler Funeral Home has been creating exceptional and meaningful experiences for Springfield area families since 1893. In 2000, the Butler Cremation Tribute Center (CTC) was built on the Butler Campus and offers families the opportunity to be fully involved in the cremation and ceremonial process.

Butler Pet Services Division: The Butler Cremation Tribute Center also accommodates a professional Pet Services Division, which offers a separate crematory dedicated exclusively to pet cremation to help people recognize these special relationships and say good-bye with dignity and respect.

Butler Funeral Homes—New Berlin: Butler Funeral Homes officially became a part of the New Berlin area communities upon its purchase of the McCullough-Delaney Funeral Home, now Butler Funeral Home—New Berlin, in 2005.
