Professional consultation with licensed personnel, which may include but is not limited to, expert advice on options to meet your needs, including essential services relating to disposition, drafting notices, etc. A Basic professional fee is payable whenever we provide services to you.

Documentation

\$275

Completion and filing of all documents necessary to carry out the services and supplies requested, including, but not limited to, death registration, burial permit, coroner's certificate for cremation. As part of this service, we will provide you with 10 proof of death certificates (at no additional fee); such certificates are usually accepted for most estate settlement purposes, but sometimes a provincial Death Certificate will be necessary and is available from the Office of the Registrar General.

Transportation of your loved one into our care. For example from a hospital, home, nursing home, etc. to our premises. Included: 40 km radius. For distances exceeding 40 km radius, a \$1.00/km fee will apply. *After hours & holidays (between 5 p.m. to 8 a.m.) an additional \$100 fee will apply for transfer from a residence, non-institutional setting, or nursing home.*

The preparation of the body for placement into the casket. May including bathing, dressing and the setting of facial features for identification for viewing without embalming.

Aftercare (see page 11 for further details) **\$395**

Post cremation follow-up to assist and advise the family of the many necessary details to be handled following a death. Includes all mail & correspondence.

Private Identification **\$295**

Immediate family (spouse, children, grandchildren, executor) gathering to say their goodbyes prior to cremation taking place. Arrangements will be made with our sister company, Reid Funeral Home, to provide a room for this to take place and will be limited to a 30 minute time frame.

Removal of Pacemaker **No Charge**

Included at no cost. As required by Ontario law, a Funeral Director must remove a pacemaker prior to cremation taking place.

Refundable Deposit for Cremated Remains **\$350**

When human remains are to be cremated, a refundable deposit **may** be required to be paid. If the cremated remains are not claimed within one year of the cremation, the deposit may be used to inter the cremated remains in common ground. If the cremated remains are claimed before they are interred, the deposit will be refunded.

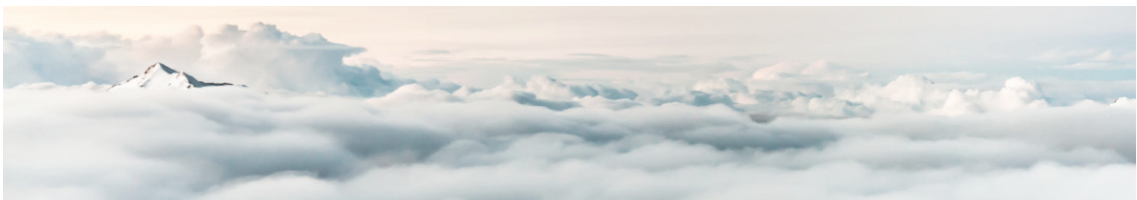

Funding

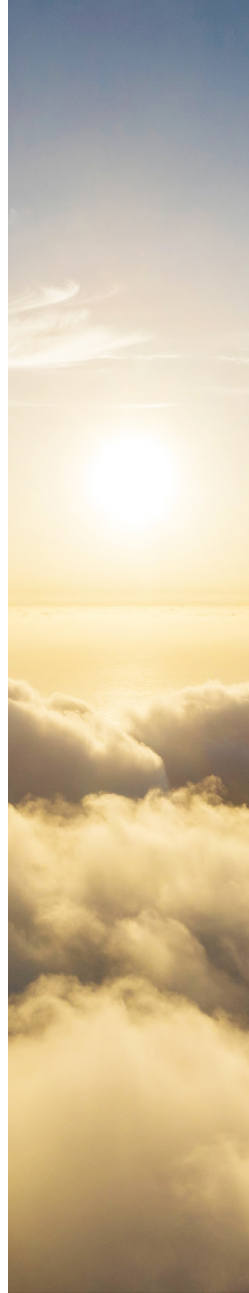
Trust (Funding Option 1)

Your funds will be placed in trust with Guaranteed Funeral Deposits (GFD) where it will accrue interest until the contract is fulfilled (when the services and supplies are delivered) or the contract is canceled.

Insurance (Funding Option 2)

You may purchase an insurance contract where the proceeds of the insurance contract will be used to pay for the services or supplies at the time they are delivered or the contract is canceled.
