

INFORMATION ABOUT SUBMITTING TO NEWSPAPERS

We realize losing a loved one is difficult, and as part of our service to you at this time, we would like to make sure the process of placing an obituary is as easy as possible.

Please read the information below; it may help answer some of your initial concern or question.

If you fill out the information on the form provided, we will help write the obituary. If you would rather compose the obituary yourself, you can use the form as a guideline if it is helpful.

We appreciate all obituaries and photos (JPEG format) emailed to us at Caren@hillcrestfunerals.com (KENNEWICK) or Marce@hillcrestfunerals.com (PASCO), or you can bring them in to our office yourself.

■ COST

Obituaries are paid advertisements. The base rate is \$101.20. The base rate includes 130 words of text. After the 130-minimum, the charge is .51 cents per word. If you would like to include a photo with the obituary, the cost is \$27 per photo, and \$53 for a double photo. However this is a one-time charge. Please make sure to send your photo in JPEG format, at least 120 dpi and as a separate attachment from your obituary. Photos embedded in Microsoft Word documents are difficult to work with and may not reproduce correctly.

The Tri-City Herald will assume that all obituaries submitted by a funeral home are approved to run and no further approval is needed. They will contact you if you have requested to receive a price quote prior to running the notice.

■ BILLING

All obituaries must be paid for in advance, so it is your responsibility to call the paper and give them credit card information before they will be ran. The Tri-City Herald can offer you payment options if you are unable to pay the balance

■ OTHER PAPERS

We will be happy to submit your obituary to other newspapers, however, they must be paid in advance. You can call the paper yourself with credit card information, or you can give us the credit card information and we will take care of it for you.
