This Disclosure/Disclaimer Form is a check list we ask those we serve to read and sign if during the arrangements for the funeral of the aforementioned decedent our funeral home did or did not do the following.

I/We who made the arrangements for the funeral and final disposition of the remains of the aforementioned decedent do hereby attest to the following:

- I/We hereby acknowledge that I/we have the legal right to arrange the funeral services for the deceased and authorize the Tri-State Funeral Services, Inc., to perform the services, provide funeral goods and incur outside charges.
- I/We were given a General Price List effective January 1, 2024 prior to discussing prices, service and merchandise.
- I/We were shown a Casket Price List effective January 1, 2024 prior to discussing prices of caskets.
- I/We were shown an Outer Burial Container Price List effective January 1, 2024 prior to discussing prices of outer burial containers.
- I/We were not told that embalming is required by law and were told that the law does not require embalming except in certain special cases. If embalming was provided, this was done with my/our permission.
- I/We were not told that any law requires embalming for direct cremations, immediate burial or a funeral using a sealed casket or if refrigeration is available and the funeral is without viewing or visitation with a closed casket.
- I/We were told that state law does not require the purchase of an outer burial container or any of the funeral goods and services. I/We have selected except as set forth on the statement of funeral goods and services selected.
- No claims were made to me/us as to the merchandise or other offerings of this funeral firm (embalming, casket, outer burial container) that embalming or use of any merchandise available from this firm would delay the decomposition of the remains for a long term or indefinite time or would protect the body from graveside substances. No representations or warranties were made to us about the protective features of caskets or outer burial containers other than those made by the manufacturer. The only warranties expressed or implied, granted in connection with goods sold with the funeral service we arranged were the expressed written warranties, if any, extended by the manufacturer therefore. No other warranties or merchandising fitness for a particular purpose were extended to us.
- I/We were told that the amount of each of the cash advance items was the actual cost to the funeral home.

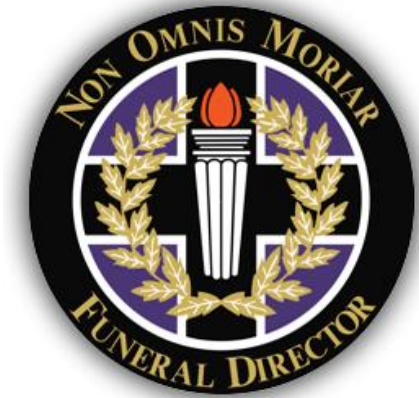

GENERAL INFORMATION

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any item you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

BASIC SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR/STAFF. \$2,000.00

Our basic service charge includes, but is not limited to, initial request for service; arrangement conference with family or responsible party; arrangement of funeral or other disposition; preparation and filing of necessary authorization and permits; recording vital statistics; preparation and placement of obituary notices; coordination with third parties providing other portions of the funeral, e.g. cemetery, crematory, and others. Also included in this charge are the overhead expenses relative to our facility such as insurance, maintenance, and utility expenses, secretarial and administrative costs, and equipment and inventory expenses.

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials and forwarding or receiving remains).

EMBALMING \$1,250.00

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with a viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

2. Funeral service at another facility – Our service includes coordination and supervision of that funeral service, and additional staff necessary to conduct funeral service at another facility \$450.00

1. Memorial service at the Reposing Chapel – Our service includes coordination and supervision of the memorial service, set-up and use of facilities \$600.00
2. Memorial service at another facility – Our service includes coordination and supervision of that memorial service and additional staff necessary to conduct the memorial service at another facility \$350.00
3. Graveside Funeral Service – Our service includes coordination and supervision of funeral service, staff to attend the funeral service and recessing equipment. \$350.00

IV. SPECIAL SERVICES

A. Forwarding Remains to Another Funeral Home

This charge includes temporary shelter of the remains, the embalming, shipping receptacle for body, necessary authorization for and basic services of staff and local transportation to airport or rail head. It does not include visitation, rites, or ceremonies prior to forwarding of the body. With minimum shipping container \$1895.00

B. Receiving Remains From Another Funeral Home

This charge includes temporary shelter of the remains, the transportation of the remains to cemetery or crematory, and the basic services of staff. It does not include visitation, funeral rites, or ceremonies \$2500.00

C. Immediate Burials \$1050.00 to \$1750.00

Our charge for immediate burial, without any attendant rites or ceremonies, includes removal and shelter of remains, local transportation to the ceremony, necessary service of staff, and authorizations.
