

Grace Point - LBA Leadership Responsibilities

Required for election to the Local Board of Administration and Kansas District Conference Delegation

(Based on I Timothy 3:8–13; Titus 1:7–9; Acts 6:1–7; Romans 12:3–8; Ephesians 4:11–13; I Corinthians 12; John 12:12–15; Malachi 3:8–10; I Corinthians 13)

1. A Growing Relationship with Jesus: Evidenced in a consistent prayer life and desire to learn from God's Word on a daily basis.

2. An exemplary life: Leaders lead by example and must demonstrate the pursuit of a Christ-honoring relationship and a lifestyle free of patterns of sin.

3. A commitment to lead: Leaders will be expected to make decisions and establish policy for the overall health and well-being of the church and its mission instead of making decisions on the basis of representing various groups and/or interests.

4. Devoted to marriage and family: Church leaders, if married, must be devoted to their spouse and strive to see that their family is well-ordered. (If they're single, they are expected to honor a commitment of sexual purity.)

5. Committed to the practice of proportionate giving: Begins by returning God's tithe to the local church.

6. Identifying and using their spiritual gift(s): Demonstrates servant-leadership through active involvement in a place of service and ministry.

7. Respecting those in authority: Willingness to submit to the leadership of the pastoral staff, other members of the LBA, and live in unity with the rest of the congregation.

8. Strive to be visionary and walk by faith: Leaders attempt to discern God's best in every decision. They are expected to be sensible, balanced in judgment, not given to quick, superficial decisions based on immature thinking.

9. Diligence to matters of character and integrity: Leaders should be well respected by unbelievers and free from hypocrisy.

10. Demonstrate the value of the impact of the local church: Will be a part of fulfilling the mission of our local church. Demonstrates the value of our environments by being a part of corporate worship, missions, small groups, family ministry, and service. Is consistent in their attendance at monthly board meetings.
