



TRASHKETBALL RULES

The Basics

- Trashcans will be set up in a pyramid formation with 1 in the front, 2 in the middle, and 3 in the back row.
- Each team will stand on their respective sides and will shoot at the opposing pyramid.
- Players must not step beyond the front trashcan (taped line).

Playing the Game

- Teams will flip a coin to see who shoots first (or play Rock/Paper/Scissors).
- Each team will take turns throwing volleyballs in an attempt to make it into the trashcan.
 - Player 1 Team A takes the first shot, Player 2 Team A takes the second shot.
 - If both shots are made, the balls will be returned to the shooting team and both players on Team A are allowed to shoot again.
 - If both shots are not made, the balls remain on Team B's side and each player takes their turn.
 - This cycle continues until all trashcans have been made on one side. If Team A (who started off with the ball first) makes all of the trashcans – the opposing team still gets to take their final turn. If and only if the Team B makes both shots, the balls will be returned to Team B for another shot.
- As trashcans are made, teams will remove them from the pyramid.
- Teams have one opportunity to re-align their trashcans if they wish.
- Game and tournament structure will be determined based on the number of teams in the tournament.
