IM SPORTS

- Provide opportunities for students to compete against their peers in a friendly and structured environment
- Participation is completely voluntary and at your own risk.

SPORTSMANSHIP

- Impacts participation eligibility
- Defined as interacting positively with all individuals (players, officials, staff & spectators) to promote a safe and fun environment.

EQUIPMENT NEEDED TO PARTICIPATE:

- Own, valid AppCard, with a CLEAR picture
- Closed toed/heeled athletic shoes
- No jewelry
- Racquet & Balls – provided by the participants. You can check out a racquet and ball at the Student Recreation Center during operating hours (found at www.urec.appstate.edu).

PARTICIPANT ELIGIBILITY

- Must have and be able to present a valid AppCard ID every time they participate (paid Activity Fees)
- For Summer Pickleball: A player may only be on **ONE** Open team for Singles and **ONE** for Doubles.
- Must have signed a PAW (Participant Agreement & Waiver) on file with the IM Sports Office and be on the sports IM Leagues Roster.

IM TEAM CAPTAIN DUTIES/RESPONSIBILITIES

- Serve as official liaison between team and IM Sports Office
- Eligibility of participants

TYPE OF SEASON

- Ladder Tournament:
 - Randomly placed on “ladder”
 - You will be responsible for challenging your opponents to matches!!!
 - You may challenge 2 spots up/down
 - You may decline up to 2 challenges
 - Two teams can play each other up to 2 times
 - You must complete 4 matches by 8/7/2018
- Arrive at least 15 minutes early on agreed upon start time for warm-up and to start your game on time.
- Champion will be the person at the top of the ladder at the end of the season: August 8, 2018.

SCHEDULES

- Ready by 12:00 pm on Wednesday, July 11. Games can start as soon as the ladder is published.
- Found on imleagues.com, IM Leagues App (free), Bulletin Board at the Student Recreation Center (across from the basketball courts)

FACILITIES

- Pickleball courts on campus: Pickleball can be played at the Student Recreation Center in the Main gym or the Aux gym (third floor).

INCLEMENT WEATHER/CANCELLATIONS

- Do not play contests in inclement weather. Safety is first priority.

COMMUNICATING INFORMATION

- Activity Programmer will assist in communicating important information from the imsports@appstate.edu email
 - Winner must submit score via IM Leagues. Opponent will have 12 hours to confirm score or it will be accepted and be final.
 - Refer to “HOW TO: Challenge Opponents in Ladder Tournament” via IM Leagues. Use this method to schedule games to ensure consistency and accuracy of the tournament.
 - If you wish to play additional, please feel free to do so on your own!
