



Campus Overview

- UTI-Lisle opened in fall of 2013, however UTI has operated a campus in Glendale Heights, Illinois since July of 1988, with more than 20,000 graduates in its 26-year history.
- The 187,000 square foot state-of-industry campus is located along the Interstate 88 research and development corporate corridor in Lisle, a suburb of Chicago.
- The campus has 41 classrooms and 80,900-square-feet used for 20 labs that support our core automotive and diesel programs. The school has the capacity to train up to 2,000 students and accommodate up to 150 staff and faculty.
- The key employers in the Chicago area that employ UTI-Lisle graduates are Associated Solutions, Crown Lift Trucks, Elmhurst Toyota, Friendly Ford, Heartland Automotive, NationalLease, Transport Refrigeration and Volvo of Lisle.
- An economic impact study submitted to the Village of Lisle determined the campus generates approximately \$50 million in direct and indirect annual economic benefits to the region.

Specialized Training

- UTI-Lisle provides the training necessary to excel as an entry-level automotive or diesel service technician.

Core Programs

- Automotive - The core automotive program teaches students how to diagnose, maintain and repair domestic and foreign automobiles.
- Diesel & Industrial - The diesel and industrial program teaches students the basic knowledge and skills to diagnose malfunctions in mechanical and electrical systems and make necessary repairs and replacements on diesel engines, commercial vehicles and heavy equipment.
- Automotive, Diesel & Industrial - This program combines all the courses from the automotive technology plus the diesel and industrial program to train students for a career as a professional technician in each of these industries.

Manufacturer-Specific Advanced Training (MSAT)

- Ford Accelerated Credential Training (FACT) – The 15-week FACT intensive training program uses Ford Motor Company curriculum, vehicles, components, and diagnostic equipment. Successful graduates earn 11 Ford STST classroom certifications, 80 required web certifications and Ford Quick Lane service technician training.
- Toyota Professional Automotive Technician (TPAT) – The 12-week TPAT program provides focused training on Toyota, Scion and Lexus procedures, components equipment and vehicles, including the Toyota Prius with its hybrid drive system.
- International Technician Education Program (ITEP) – The 6-week ITEP course can be added to the core Automotive or Diesel & Industrial programs. Students receive hands-on training to diagnose and repair trucks, school buses, severe service vehicles and mid-range diesel engines.
- Daimler Trucks Finish First (DTNA) – DTNA is a 12-week program that offers students the opportunity to earn a DTNA Service Technician certification preparing them to work with the Freightliner, Sterling and Western Star brands.
- Peterbilt Technician Institute (PTI) – PTI is a 12-week program that provides exclusive classroom and hands-on experience with the complete lineup of Peterbilt trucks and PACCAR Engines. Students are sponsored by Peterbilt dealerships which then offer graduates employment upon completion of the program.

Accreditation

- UTI-Lisle is accredited by the Accrediting Commission of Career Schools and Colleges (ACCSC), which is recognized by the U.S. Department of Education.
- UTI-Lisle received the ACCSC School of Excellence Award for the 2013-2014 Academic Year. This is the highest honor awarded by the Commission and is given to schools for their commitment to the expectations and rigors of ACCSC accreditation, as well as the efforts made by the institution to maintain strong student outcomes.

STEM & Educator Outreach

- UTI is a member of the STEM Education Coalition, participating in a nationwide initiative that reflects our commitment to ensure science, technology, engineering and math skills are interwoven throughout our curriculum.
- UTI-Lisle has been designated a 2015 STEM JobsSM Approved College by Victory Media, the leader in helping America's military veterans transition to civilian life. Schools were scored on publicly available data and responses to proprietary questions around three key indicators of success: STEM job alignment, STEM job placement and diversity in a school's STEM programs.

Community & Industry Champions

- UTI-Lisle employees and their families, as well as students, are actively involved in the community and have volunteered at numerous events including at the Eyes to the Skies Festival, Lisle's largest annual community festival.
- The campus is a member of the Lisle Chamber, Naperville Area Chamber and Illinois State Chamber of Commerce.
- Campus staff and students have rolled up their sleeves to host annual blood drives. These drives have provided more than 4,000 donations to the Heartland Blood Centers, which serves 47 hospitals in 12 counties throughout Illinois.
- UTI-Lisle offers six annual community scholarships: two for local residents of the Village of Lisle, two for graduating high school seniors from Lisle District 202, and two for graduating seniors from Naperville District 203.
- In May 2014, UTI-Lisle hosted the statewide Illinois Ford Motor Co./AAA Student Auto Skills Competition for high school students with winners earning thousands of dollars in scholarships to attend UTI.
- UTI-Lisle hosted the Illinois Trucking Association's (ITA) inaugural Illinois Professional Technician & Diagnostic Competition in July 2014.
- The Illinois State Chamber and the Illinois Development Council named UTI's relocation to its Lisle campus as one of the state's top six economic development projects for 2013 and presented UTI-Lisle with an Economic Development in Illinois (Edie) Award.
- The Construction Industry Service Corporation (CISCO) named the Lisle campus its 2014 suburban project of the year.
