[November 7, 2017, Macau] Last week, a group of 60 professionals and practitioners from the local hospitality and catering industry visited MGM MACAU for an insightful presentation on MGM's occupational safety and health (OSH) initiatives, followed by a guided tour of the resort's catering operations and award-winning kitchens.

The Catering Industry Occupational Safety and Health Tour was organized by Labour Affairs Bureau of the Macao SAR Government (DSAL).
