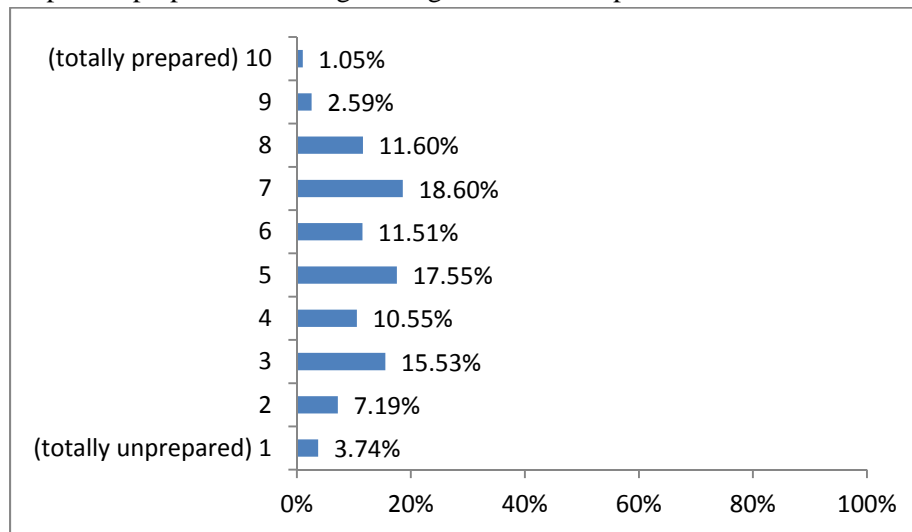

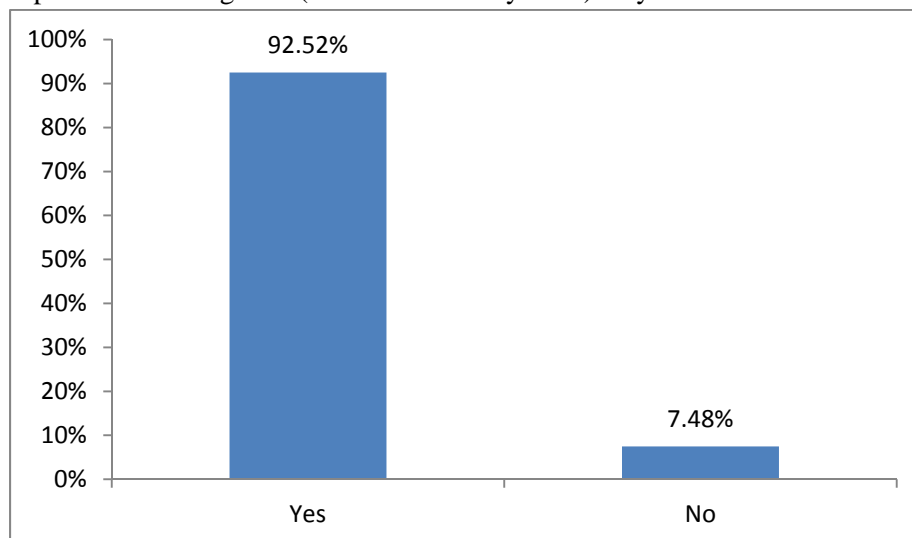

- 2) During the H1N1 outbreak during the winter and spring of 09, did patients come to your emergency department seeking care (or to confirm they have) they had H1N1flu?

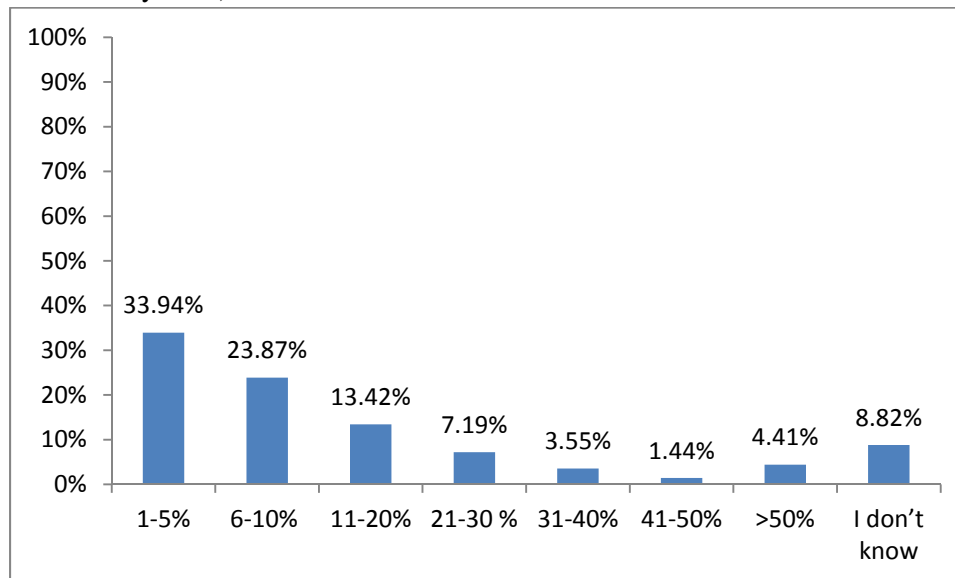

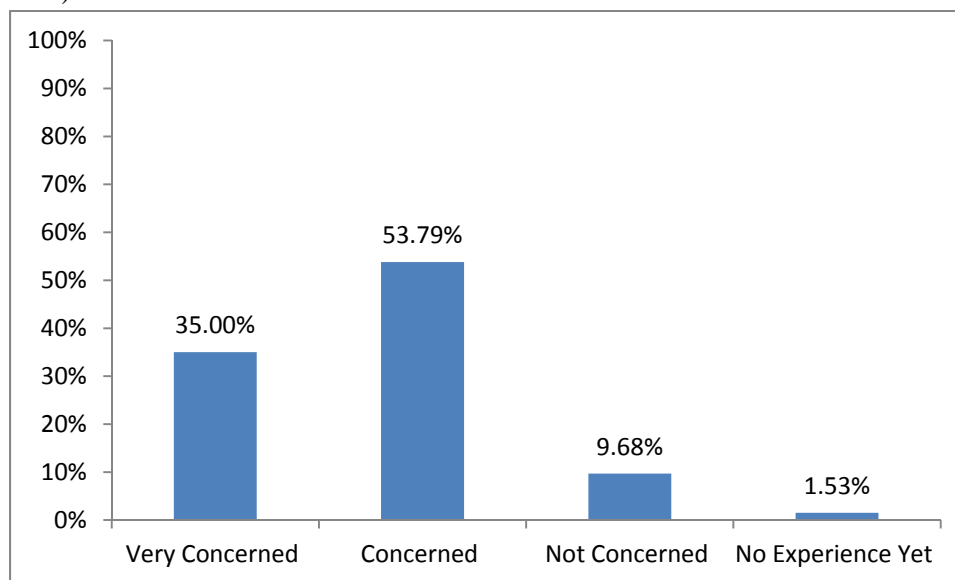

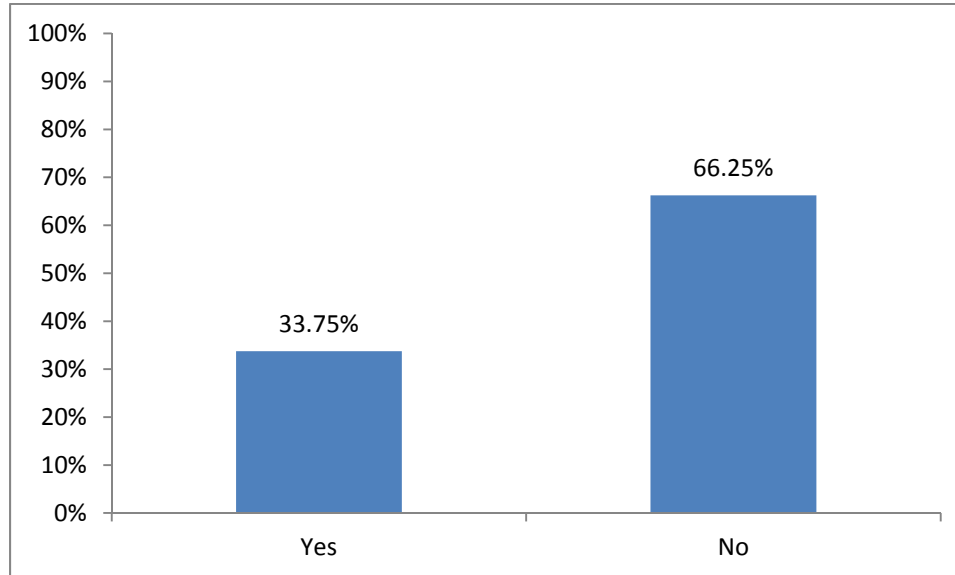

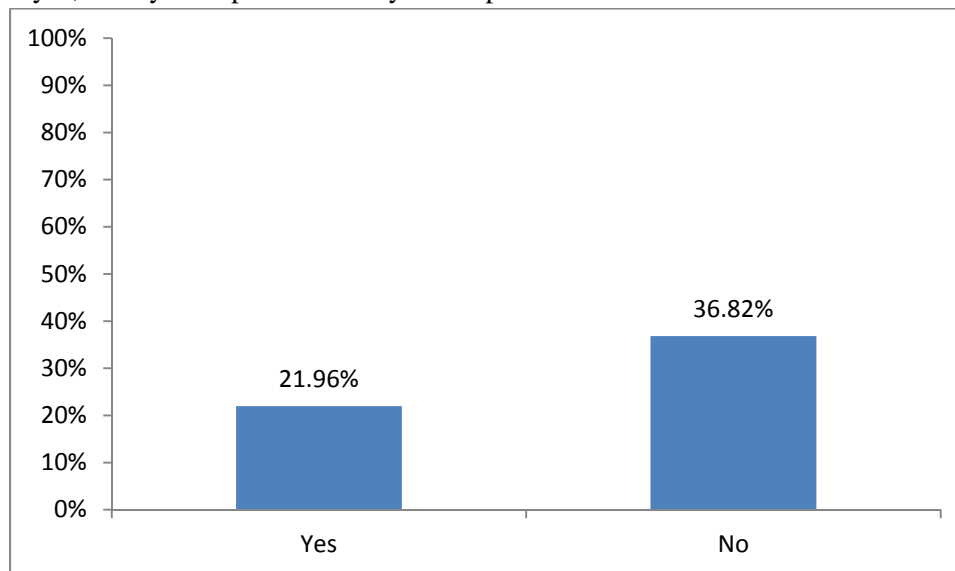

6) If yes, have you implemented any of the plan?

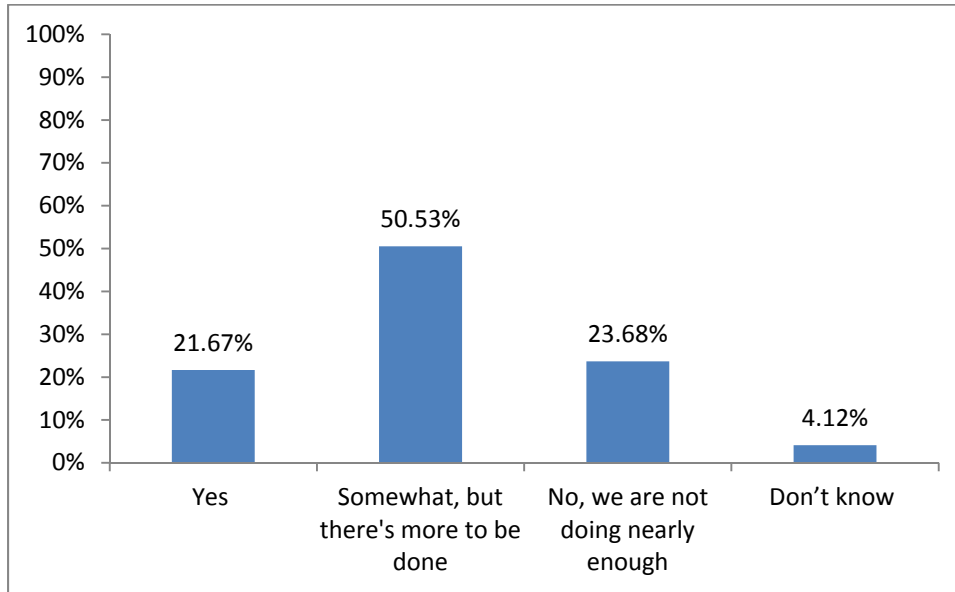

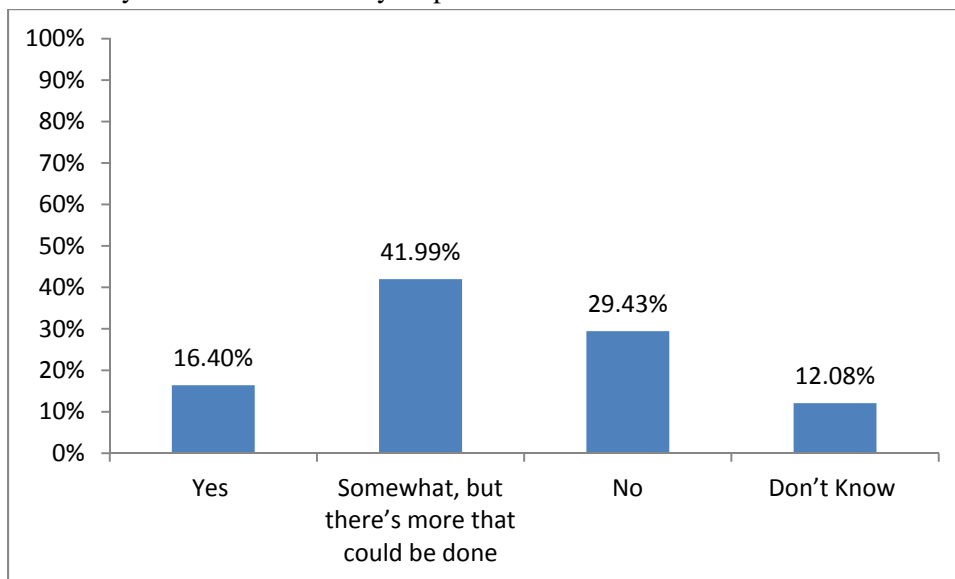

- 8) In your opinion, do you think the federal government is doing everything it can to give you the resources you need to effectively respond to a severe flu outbreak?



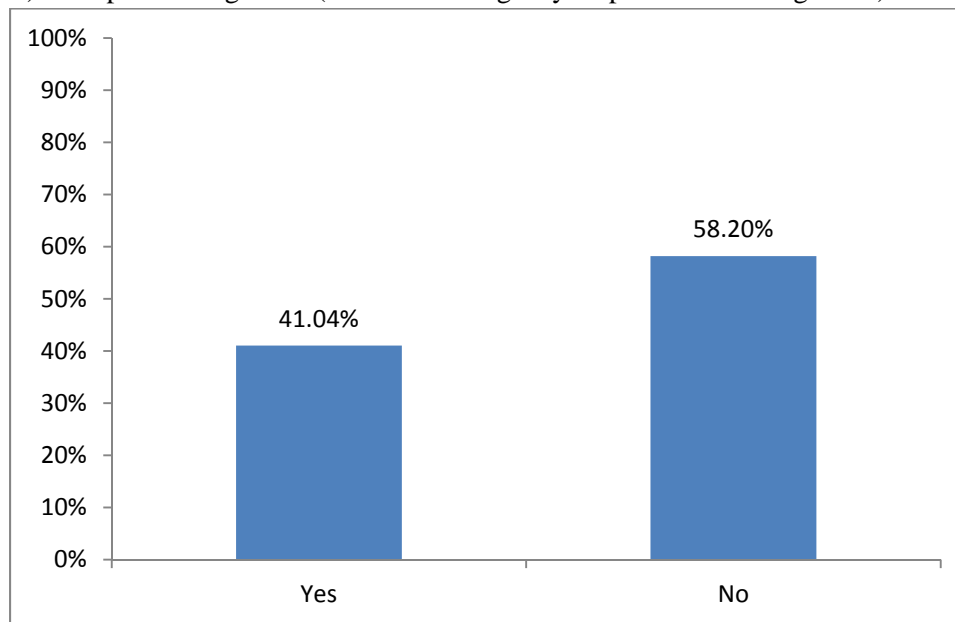

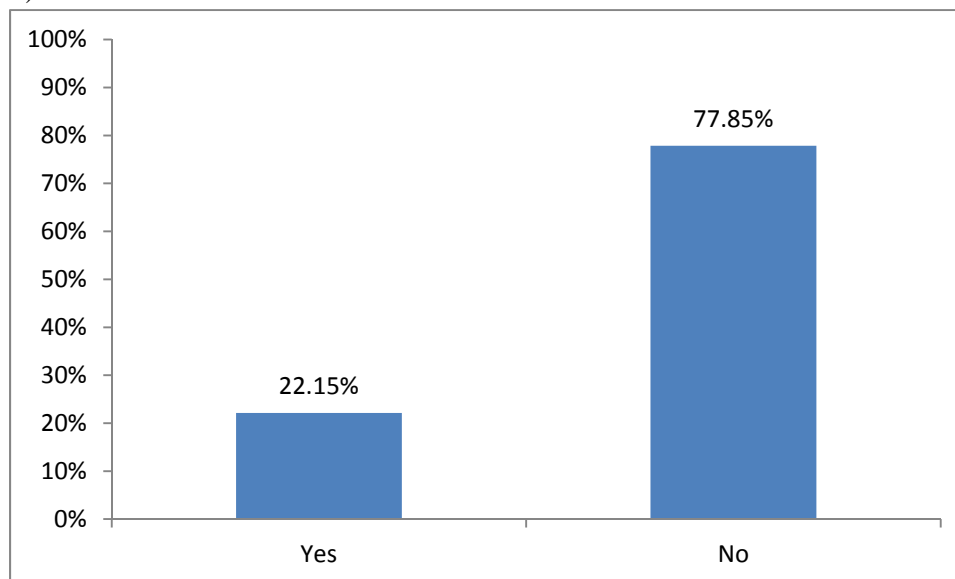

B) Patient Call Center

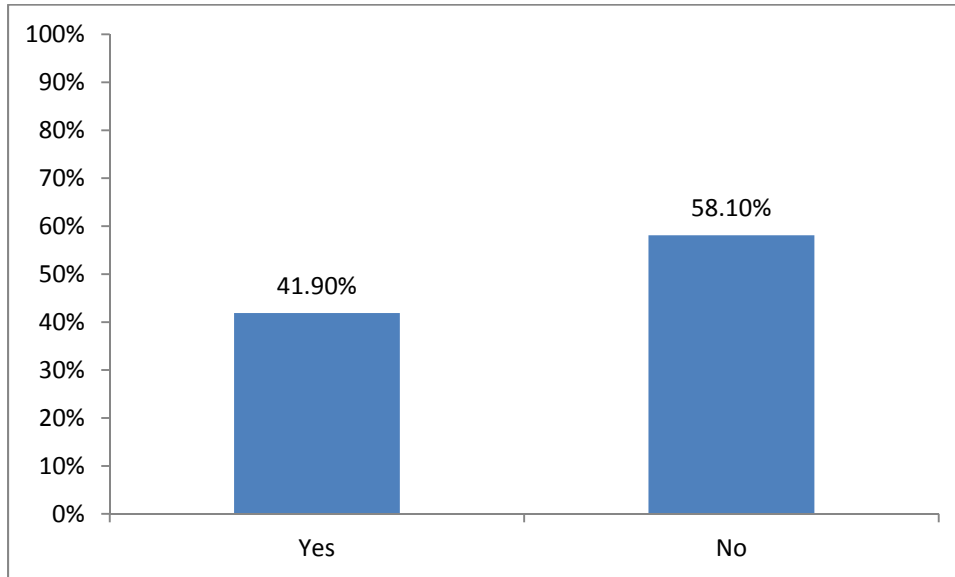

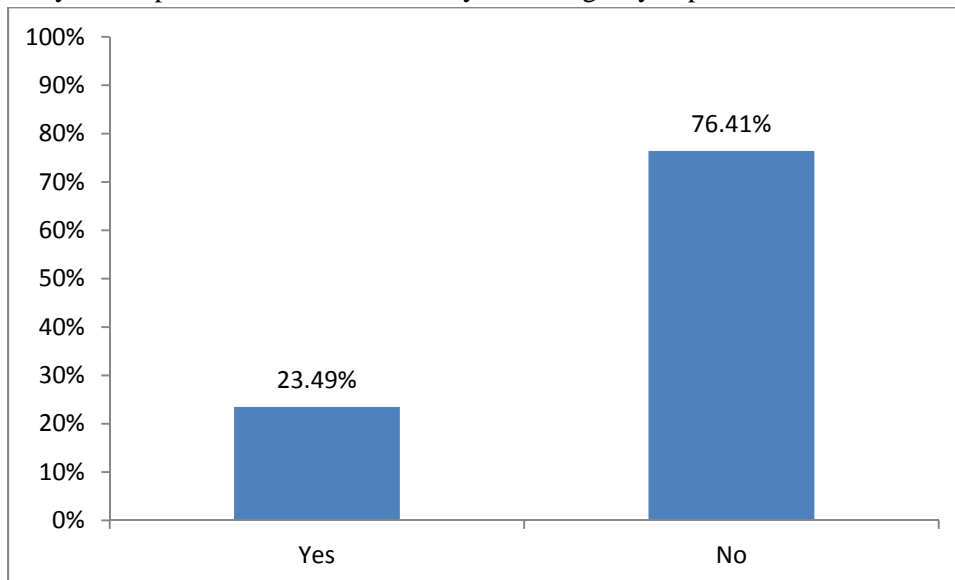

10) Are you a department director/chair of your emergency department?

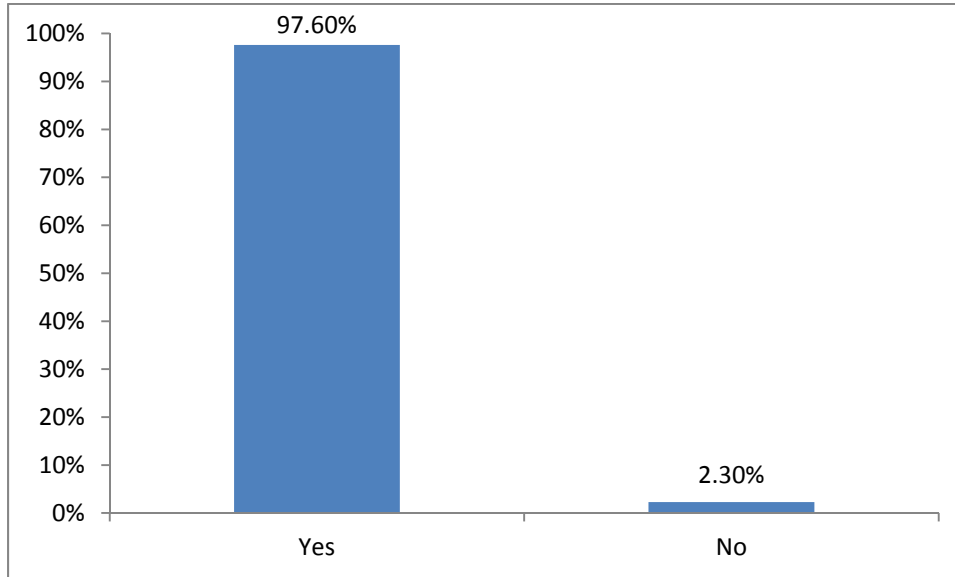

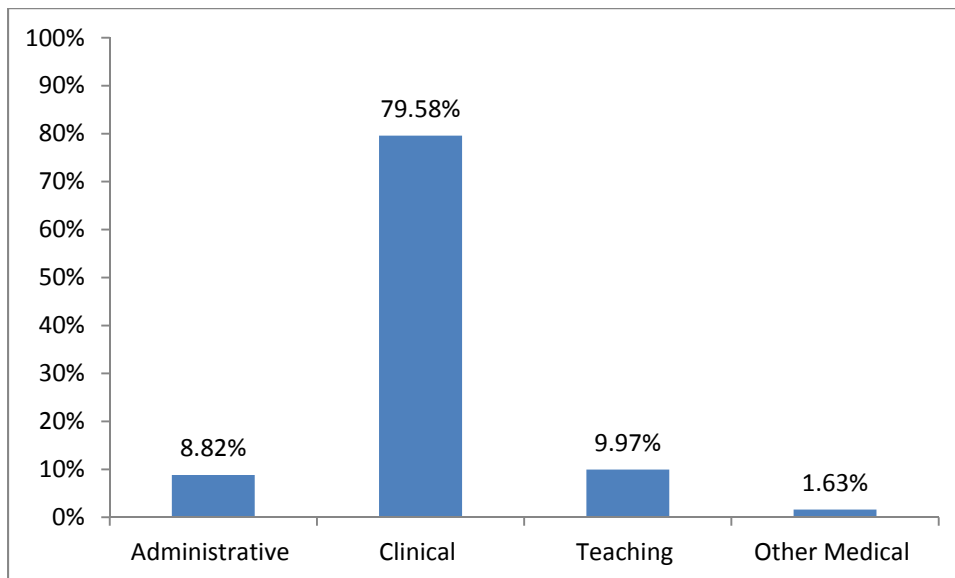
