

THE BIG POUR

FACT SHEET



We're taking a major step toward building our Northwestern Mutual Tower and Commons as the concrete mat foundation for The Tower is poured over a 27-hour period beginning at 7 p.m. Friday, March 27 and concluding by about 10 p.m. Saturday, March 28.

About 10,000 cubic yards of concrete will be poured, requiring 50 different cement trucks to make about 1,000 trips from three different cement plants. Based on what we know, we believe this to be the largest continuous concrete pour in Wisconsin history.

Preparation for “the Big Pour” and cleanup afterward will require some street and sidewalk closures from 8 a.m. Thursday, March 26 to 5 p.m. Tuesday, March 31. The closures are:

- 1 Mason Street from Cass to Prospect. (The north sidewalk on Mason will be open.)
- 2 On the east and south sides of the construction site, the west lane of Prospect and north lane of Wisconsin Avenue from Mason to Cass. The sidewalk will also be closed.
- 3 The east lane of Van Buren Street between Wisconsin and Mason. (This lane is already closed.)
- 4 Cudahy Tower residents will be able to access their parking garage and lot from Marshall Street.
