Dear Eric Nichols,

Thank you for your interest in becoming a University of Missouri-Kansas City (UMKC) School of Dentistry patient. The UMKC School of Dentistry combines dental education with dental health care services for the community. The students are required to provide comprehensive care; as such, as a patient you can expect to receive complete and thorough treatment of all your dental needs.

A student dentist will perform your treatment under the supervision of a faculty member. This attention will require increased time spent in the dental chair. Appointments are scheduled Monday through Friday only, usually at 9:00AM or 1:00PM, and last for most of the morning or afternoon. You should be prepared to come in for numerous appointments to complete your treatment. There are no child care facilities and no children are allowed in clinical areas unless they are receiving treatment. Please leave your children at home. Patients under the age of 18 that are not emancipated must be accompanied by a legal parent or guardian. On a per case basis, the School may require documentation of guardianship.

***** All screening patients, as well the parents/guardians of minors, must present a current government issued photo ID with the correct mailing address in order to receive care. If your address has changed, please call 816-235-2111 and inform the attendant; you will be notified what to bring in addition to your ID.**

Dental care is not free at UMKC School of Dentistry. Once the initial exam and x-rays are complete, the fees average one-third to one-half the cost of private care. Your student dentist will discuss cost and payment methods and obtain your approval before beginning your dental work ****It is your responsibility to pay all fees****. If you have private dental insurance please bring this information with you. The School will file your insurance claims and you will then be reimbursed by your insurance company. If you have Missouri or Kansas Medicaid please contact your case worker to determine if you are eligible to receive dental benefits.

The school treats a wide variety of patients in our hygiene, dental and graduate programs. At the initial visit, you will be assessed by a faculty member. At that time it will be determined which program best meets your needs. X-rays may be taken or scheduled to be taken following the screening appointment. The fee for x-rays is \$62.00 which must be paid in full at the time of your visit. If you have any current dental x-rays, bring them with you, as well as a list of all medications you take. No dental treatment will be completed at your screening appointment.

Directions from the WEST

- East on I-70 to I-670 east
- Take I-670 through downtown then follow I-70 to the exit for South Hwy 71
- Hwy 71 south to 22nd St./Paseo exit
- West (right) on 22nd to Charlotte
- South (left) on Charlotte to 25th St.
- West (right) on 25th to Holmes (one block)
- The UMKC School of Dentistry is located on the northwest corner of 25th and Holmes. See parking instructions below.

Directions from the SOUTHWEST

- North on I-35 to I-70 east
- Take I-70 through downtown to exit for South Hwy 71
- Hwy 71 south to 22nd St./Paseo exit
- West (right) on 22nd to Charlotte
- South (left) on Charlotte to 25th St.
- West (right) on 25th to Holmes (one block)
- The UMKC School of Dentistry is located on the northwest corner of 25th and Holmes. See parking instructions below.

Directions from the EAST

- West on I-70
- Take 13th St. exit (notice the sign for the UMKC School of Medicine) to Charlotte (first light)
- South (left) on Charlotte to 25th St.
- West (right) on 25th to Holmes (one block)

Directions from the SOUTHEAST

- North on U.S. Highway 71 to Paseo exit
- Left (southwest) on Paseo to 25th St.

Directions from the NORTH

- South on I-35 to east I-70 (near downtown)

DENTAL SCHOOL PARKING

At the corner of 25th and Holmes, drive North on Holmes. The School of Dentistry building will be on your left. Halfway down the hill turn left at the sign for Children's Mercy Hospital Emergency Services and Dental School parking. At the top of the drive turn right and pull up to the guard gate.

The undergraduate student clinic is located on the first floor. Report to the reception desk for check-in.
