Australian UHF CB was originally allocated spectrum from 476.425 to 477.425MHz with 25kHz spacing providing for 40 channels. With improvements in technology the channel spacing was reduced to 12.5kHz in 2011 which all new radios now use to access 75/77 channels, old radios were to be unlawful after 2016 (but still allowed). New Channel numbers above the original 40 are NOT in extended frequencies, but are fitted in between the old channel numbers.

Eg new 41 is 476.4375 between old 1 at 476.4250 and old 2 at 476.4500
However existing data only channels 22 and 23 remain full 25kHz width so new 61-63 are unusable (at present)

If your radio allows it pre-set channels 1 to 8 and 41 to 48 to duplex/repeater mode
Set your scan function for channels 11, 40 and your interests / travelling companions.
[Trucks on the Pacific Highway still use (Toll Transport) channel 29 for Highway talk, so add that too when on the East Coast]
