

FN 15™ Military Collector Series M16 Limited Edition Rifle Owner's Manual Addendum



We are pleased that you have chosen an FN 15 Military Collector Series M16 Limited Edition rifle. The FN 15 Military Collector Series M16 shares the same reliability, durability, accuracy and many of the operating features as the standard FN 15 Rifle. However, it has additional special features such as a backup iron sight, an ambidextrous selector, a Knights Armament M5 Rifle RAS Assembly (rail adapter system with removable rail panels), and a vertical pistol grip. This addendum will cover the operation of those necessary specific features where they differ from the standard FN 15 Rifle. The common operations and features are covered in the FN 15 Owner's Manual supplied with your FN 15 Military Collector Series M16 Limited Edition rifle.

Before inspecting or making any adjustments on the FN 15 Military Collector Series M16 fully read and understand completely the Owner's Manual as well as this Addendum. Place the "safety" in the on safe position, remove the magazine, open the action and ensure the chamber is empty as explained in Section 15.1 of your Owner's Manual. Always keep the muzzle pointed in a safe direction. Failure to follow these warnings may result in serious injury or death.

2. Rear Sight Use and Adjustment

The backup sight (BUS) is provided as a primary sighting system or backup sighting system if an optic is also being used. The BUS will fold down when not in use and can be quickly deployed when needed.


WARNING

Before manipulating or making any sight adjustments, place the "safety" in the on safe position, remove the magazine, open the action and ensure the chamber is empty as explained in Section 15.1 of your Owner's Manual. Always keep the muzzle pointed in a safe direction.

Failure to follow these warnings may result in serious injury or death

a. Deploying and Folding the Knight's Armament USMC Backup Sight

To deploy the sight, pull up the rear aperture sight leaf.





b. Zeroing the FN 15 Military Collector Series M16

The BUS is adjustable for windage and elevation up to 600 meters. To zero the FN 15 Military Collector Series M16, the line on the sight cam on the left side needs to align with the 300-meter mark. Refer to the leaflet from Knight's Armament Company included with your rifle for zeroing and operating instructions for details.

WARNING

Before removing, moving or reattaching the rear sight, place the "safety" in the on safe position, remove the magazine, open the action and ensure the chamber is empty as explained in Section 15.1 of your Owner's Manual. Always keep the muzzle pointed in a safe direction.

Failure to follow these warnings may result in serious injury or death.

3. Knights Armament M5 Rail Adapter System

The Knights Armament M5 Rail Adapter System (RAS) is installed on the FN 15 Military Collector Series M16 in place of the standard round handguards. The RAS system features MIL-STD 1913 rails at the 12, 3, 6, and 9 o'clock positions for mounting various rifle accessories, including the vertical pistol grip. There are eight rails covers installed. Retaining clips on the rail covers will lock into the slots at either end of the adapter rail. To remove rail covers, press clip and slide panel off.







WARNING

Before installing any sights, lasers or other devices on the rifle, place the "safety" in the on safe position, remove the magazine, open the action and ensure the chamber is empty as explained in Section 15.1 of your Owner's Manual. Always keep the muzzle pointed in a safe direction. Failure to follow these warnings may result in serious injury or death.

WARNING

Do not mount any sight, laser, or other device which interferes with normal operation of the carbine or extends beyond or in front of the muzzle. Ensure any sight or device attached to this rail system is firmly mounted.

4. UID label and QR code

Your FN 15 Military Collector Series M16 features a QR (Quick Response) Code within the UID label. With this QR code, you can scan it with your smartphone and obtain information at www.fnamerica.com.



NOTE

This rifle is a semi-automatic replica of the military firearm and despite the "Auto" marking, it is not automatic!

A laminated "Auto" disclaimer card is included with this rifle.
