INTERNATIONAL PROGRAMS

International Education and Initiatives

International Training Program Bundle - \$40,000

Includes the International Palliative Care Workshops, Multidisciplinary Cancer, Management Courses, and Cancer Control in Primary Care

Workshops and courses begin as early as January 1, 2020

ASCO International-TBD

 Provides funding to support the work that ASCO International does globally to implement quality improvement, provide professional development and support innovative cancer research

ASCO International

International Research Grants and Awards

International Innovation Grant (IIG) - \$23,000 per supporter

Hypothesis-driven research grants that fund a specific research project for one year that may result in the discovery of new knowledge about how to advance cancer control in a low- or middle-income setting

Tentative commitment deadline – December 2019

Long-term International Fellowship (LIFe) - \$130,000 per supporter

Provides early-career oncologists in low- to middle-income countries the support and resources needed to advance their training by deepening their relationship with a mentor in the United States or Canada

Tentative commitment deadline – March 1, 2020



INTERNATIONAL PROGRAMS

International Research Grants and Awards

International Development Education Awards (IDEA) - \$11,000 - \$33,000 per supporter

- Provides support for oncologists in developing countries to participate in the ASCO Annual Meeting and visit a cancer center in the United States or Canada
- Tentative commitment deadline January 1, 2020

Global Research Fund - \$57,500 per supporter

- Provides research funding to early-career investigators to encourage and promote quality research in global oncology and to develop the next generation researchers to address global health needs
- Tentative commitment deadline February 1, 2020

JCO Global Oncology

JCO Global Oncology (formerly Journal of Global Oncology) - \$50,000

- An online-only, open access publication, accessible through website and mobile devices
- Publishes high quality, peer-reviewed research, reviews, practical articles, editorials, commentaries, case reports and meeting proceedings on cancer care delivery and research in countries in settings with limited healthcare resources
- Recognition begins January 1, 2020 and can be added at any time



Conquer Cancer Research Grants and Awards

Advanced Clinical Research Award (ACRA) - \$500,000 per supporter

Three-year grant that funds cancer researchers in their 4th-9th year of a fulltime faculty appointment in a clinical department at an academic medical institution

• Tentative commitment deadline – February 1, 2020

Career Development Award (CDA) - \$230,000 per supporter

Three-year grant intended to support proposals with a clinical research focus. Provides funding to clinical investigators who have received their initial faculty appointment to establish an independent clinical research program

Tentative commitment deadline – February 1, 2020

Research Professorship - \$550,000 per supporter

Provides flexible cancer research funding to full professors who have made significant contributions to cancer research and are dedicated to mentoring the next generation of researchers

Tentative commitment deadline – February 1, 2020

Young Investigator Award (YIA) - \$57,500 per supporter

One-year grant designed to encourage and promote high quality research in clinical oncology by providing funds to promising investigators during the transition from a fellowship program to a faculty appointment

Tentative commitment deadline – February 1, 2020

Medical Student Rotation (MSR) for Underrepresented Populations - \$9,775-\$29,325 per supporter

Provides 8- to 10-week clinical or clinical research oncology rotations for U.S. medical students from populations underrepresented in medicine who are interested in pursuing oncology as a career

Tentative commitment deadline – February 1, 2020



Conquer Cancer Research Grants and Awards

Resident Travel Award (RTA) for Underrepresented Populations - \$1,725-\$17,250 per supporter

Provides financial support for residents from underrepresented populations to attend the ASCO Annual Meeting to be exposed to the latest clinical oncology research

Commitment deadline – March 1, 2020

Merit Awards - \$18,750-\$36,250 per supporter

Awarded to physicians (MD or DO) in an oncology fellowship-training program or doctoral degree candidates (such as PharmD or PhD) who are enrolled in an approved oncology specialty-training program at the time of abstract submission Provided at the GI Symposium, Immuno-Oncology Symposium, GU Symposium, ASCO Annual Meeting, ASCO Quality Care Symposium, and the Supportive Care in Oncology Symposium

Commitment deadline to be recognized for all meetings – December 1, 2019

ASCO Special Awards

B.J. Kennedy Award and Lecture for Scientific Excellence in Geriatric Oncology - \$6,000

Honors individuals who have demonstrated outstanding leadership or contributed scientific work (laboratory, clinical, or epidemiologic) of major importance to the field of geriatric oncology

Tentative commitment deadline – March 1, 2020

Distinguished Achievement Award - TBD

Awarded to an ASCO member who has demonstrated extraordinary broad-based leadership and/or mentorship in the field of oncology

Tentative commitment deadline – March 1, 2020

Humanitarian Award - TBD

Recognizes an oncologist who personifies ASCO's mission and values by going above and beyond the call of duty in providing outstanding patient care through innovative means or exceptional service or leadership in the United States or abroad

Tentative commitment deadline – March 1, 2020

David A. Karnofsky Memorial Award and Lecture - \$27,500

Recognizes an oncologist who has made outstanding contributions to cancer research, diagnosis, and/or treatment

Tentative commitment deadline – March 1, 2020



ASCO Special Awards

Brigid Leventhal Special Merit Award - \$2,500

Awarded to a physician in an oncology fellowship training program or a doctoral degree candidate whose research abstract is selected as the highest-ranking abstract submitted in pediatric oncology for presentation at the ASCO Annual Meeting

Tentative commitment deadline – March 1, 2020

Pain and Symptom Management Special Merit Award - \$2,250

Awarded to a physician in an oncology fellowship training program or a doctoral degree candidate whose research abstract is selected as the highest-ranking abstract submitted in pain and symptom management for presentation at the ASCO Annual Meeting

Tentative commitment deadline – March 1, 2020

Partners in Progress Award - TBD

Recognizes an individual involved in patient advocacy activities that affect public awareness about cancer, its causes, cures or treatment, or activities that result in additional legislative or fiscal support for cancer research, treatment, prevention or care

Tentative commitment deadline – March 1, 2020

Pediatric Oncology Award and Lecture - \$5,500

Recognizes a pediatric oncologist who has demonstrated outstanding leadership or achievement in the field

Tentative commitment deadline – March 1, 2020



ASCO Special Awards

Science of Oncology Award and Lecture - \$11,000

Honors the contributions of innovative basic and translational scientists in cancer research

Tentative commitment deadline – March 1, 2020

Special Recognition Award - \$2,500

Awarded to an ASCO member whose achievements have had a transforming and lasting effect in areas of clinical oncology, cancer research, clinical trials, reimbursement, and patient advocacy activities

Tentative commitment deadline – March 1, 2020

Public Service Award - TBD

Recognizes an individual involved in legislative, political action, or community service activities that impact public awareness about cancer, its causes, cures or treatments, or activities that result in additional legislative or fiscal support for cancer research, treatment, prevention or care

Tentative commitment deadline – March 1, 2020

ASCO Health Policy Fellowship - TBD

One-year program that aims to provide physicians with the necessary skills to shape cancer policy through active participation in policy development, small-group teaching sessions, training and communication in leadership skills, meetings with lawmakers in Congress and federal agencies, and a mentored research project



PATIENT/PROVIDER RESOURCES AND ADVOCACY

State/Regional Affiliate Program - \$20,000

Provides assistance to state and regional societies in addressing the practical issues facing physicians who care for people with cancer.

Program starts as early as January 1, 2020

Patient Advocate Scholarship Program Bundle - \$30,000

Provides grants to a select number of patient advocates to attend the ASCO Annual Meeting, GI Symposium, ASCO-SITC Clinical Immuno-Oncology Symposium, GU Symposium, and ASCO Quality Care Symposium.

Commitment deadline to be recognized at all meetings – November 30, 2019

ASCO Guidelines Mobile Application - \$20,000

Designed in response to member feedback to make ASCO guidelines more user-friendly by providing interactive tools and guidelines for use at the bedside and/or in clinic by members of the oncology care team.

Commitment deadline – as early as January 1, 2020, but can be added at any time

Cancer.Net - \$50,000*

Quality Training Program (QTP) - \$40,000

- A CME program that empowers practice teams to improve clinical care and operational performance by teaching teams how to balance quality improvement (QI) projects with demanding schedules and competing priorities
- Prepares oncology providers to design, implement, and lead successful QI activities in busy practice settings around a five-step Framework

Delivering Quality Care in Medically Underserved Communities - TBD

 Supports the continued development and implementation of quality improvement services for medically underserved communities, as well as help fund the creation of new services
