Eligibility

Open to Ph.D. candidates in fields related to the collections (such as **History, Political Philosophy, English, Literature, Material Texts**, etc.) whose dissertation proposal has been formally approved by their department.

Three Collaborative Short-Term Fellowships are available for graduate dissertation research in the complementary holdings of **the Huntington Library** and **Florida Atlantic University's Weiner Spirit of America Collection**. The collections are particularly strong in the **political and cultural history of 17th-c. England** and **18th-c. America**, but also reach well into the 19th century and touch on other parts of Europe.

Funding, Timing, and Location

To create a collaborative scholarly community around the *Weiner Spirit of America* Collection, all three fellows will be resident in Boca Raton, FL, simultaneously in October 2026. Each individual may go to the Huntington at any time between July 1, 2026, and June 30, 2027. **Fellows receive \$6,000 to cover travel expenses:** \$2,500 from FAU and \$3,500 from the Huntington.
