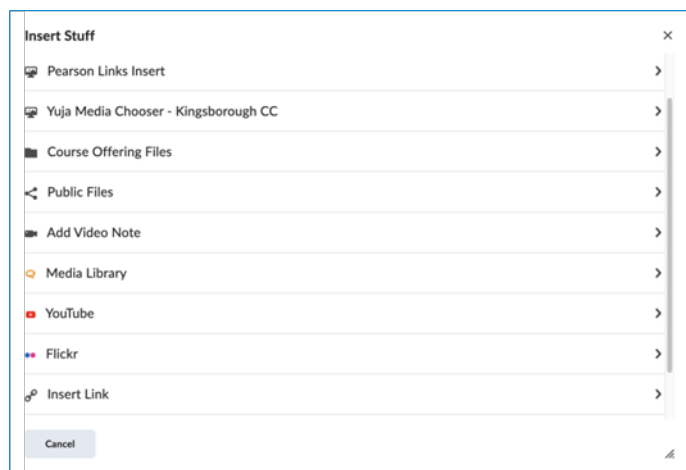
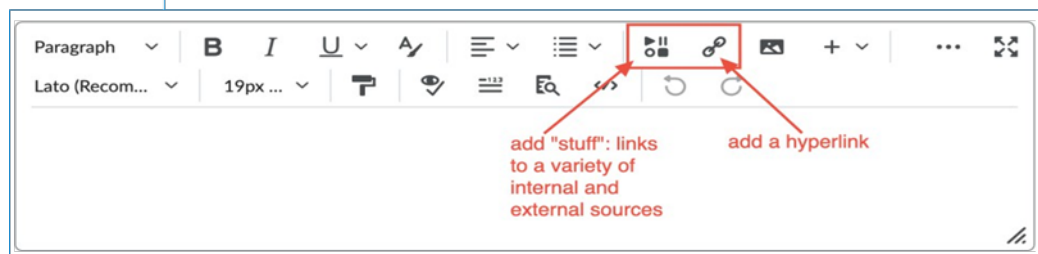




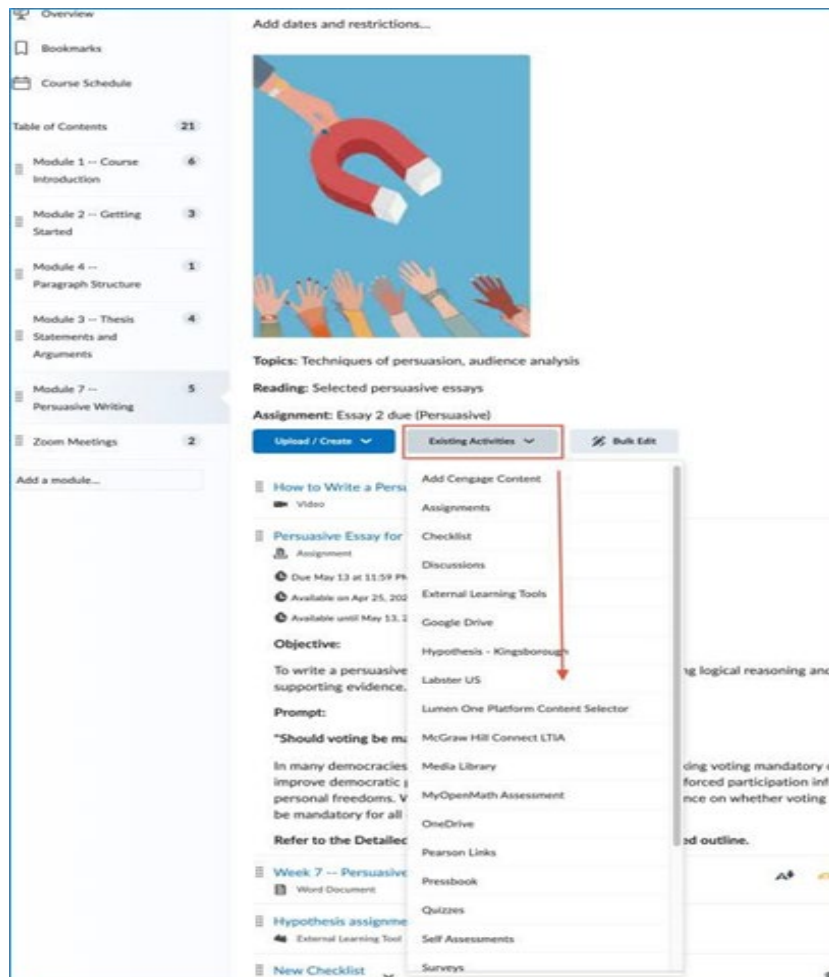
Adding Resource Links

Links are used in Brightspace to connect different items within a course or connect to external sources. Using links makes your course easier for students to navigate. The different types of resource links you can add to your Brightspace course are:

- Hyperlinks to web content such as YouTube videos or websites
- Quick links to existing assessments, content, and activities
- External tools or open educational resources
- What Brightspace calls “stuff”, which allows you to add a variety of internal or external sources

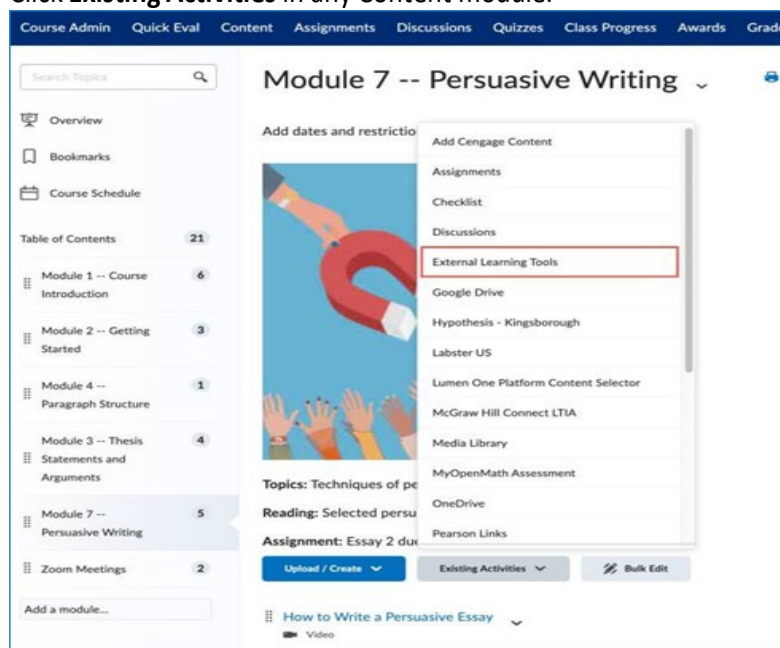


- You can also add External Learning tools from the Content menu. These resources include publisher resources, media tools such as Yuja, communication tools such as Zoom, and social annotation tools such as Hypothesis. To use most of these, or to add a link to an activity that already exists in your course, click on **Existing Activities** in Content and select from the menu:

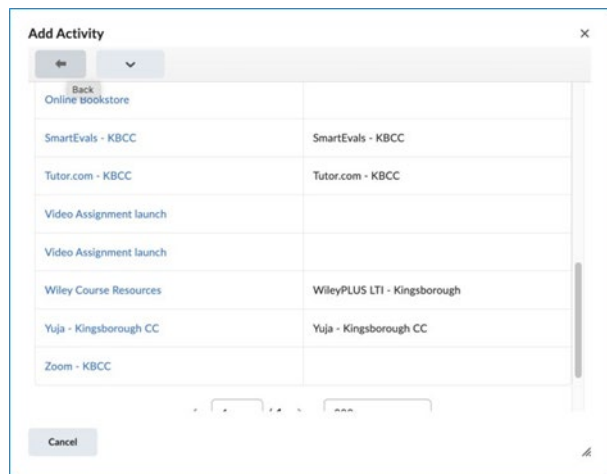


To add any External Learning Tool:

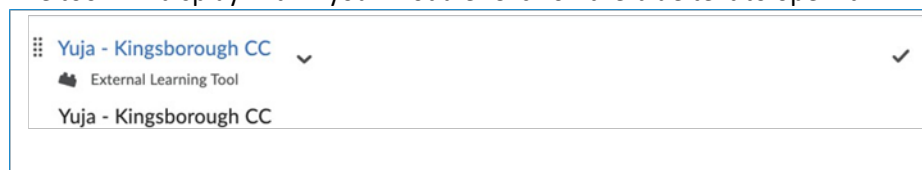
- Click **Existing Activities** in any Content module.



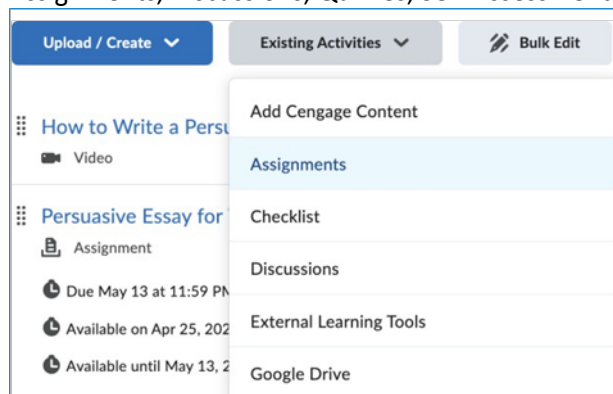
- Select a tool you want to add by clicking on it.



- The tool will display within your module. Click on the blue text to open it.



- The **Existing Activities** button also allows you to activities you may have created in a Brightspace tool such as Assignments, Discussions, Quizzes, Self-Assessments and more within a content module.



- Once you select the specific item category you want to add a list of all of the items in that category will appear.
