



Conditional Release

Conditional Release in Brightspace allows you to control when and how course content becomes available to students based on specific criteria. This feature enables you to set conditions such as date restrictions, grade requirements, group membership, or the completion of prior activities before students can access certain materials. By using Conditional Release, you can create personalized learning paths, ensuring students engage with content in a structured and meaningful way. Conditional Release also supports differentiated instruction and enhances student engagement by providing timely resources.

Adding Conditional Release

You can add conditional release to many elements of Brightspace. You will find the Conditional Release tool as follows:

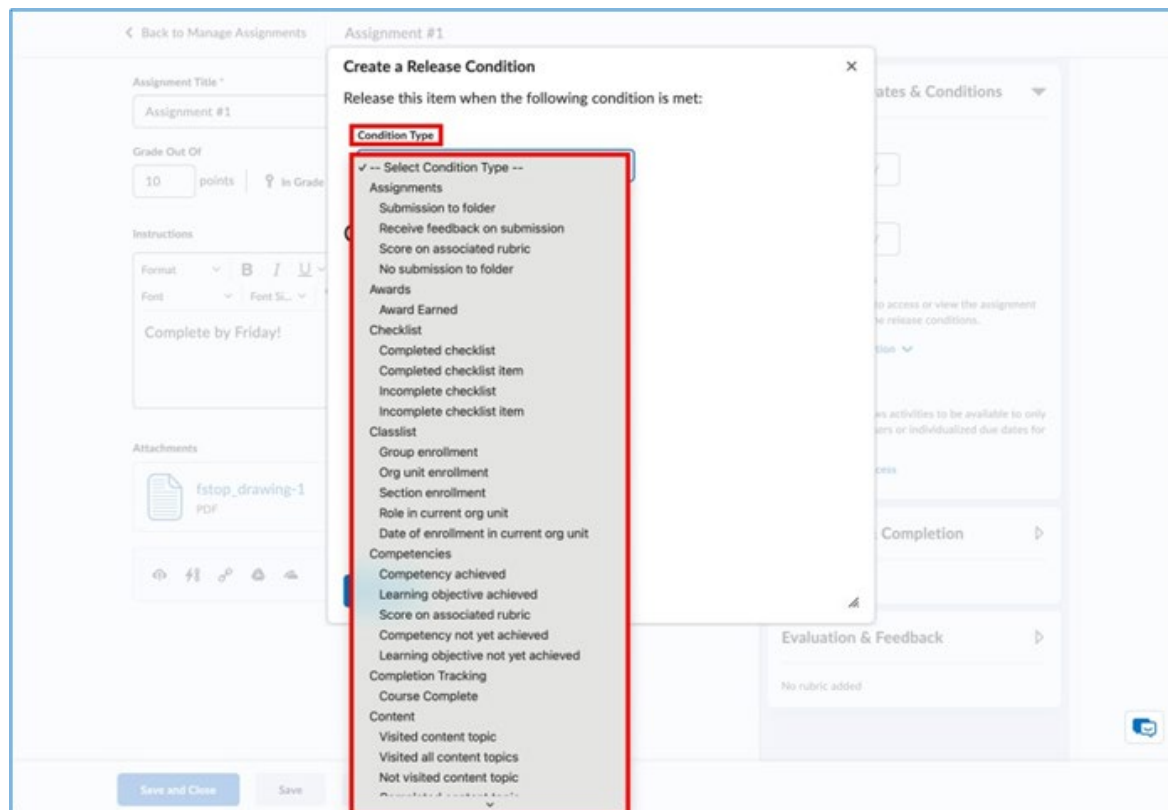

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To add Conditional Release:

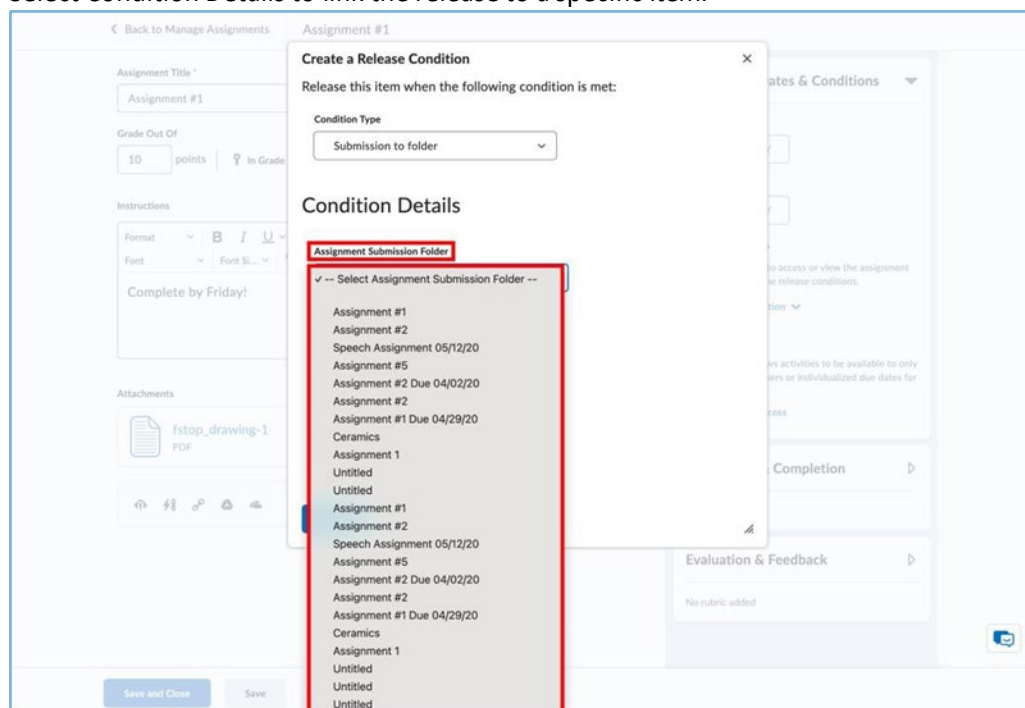
- Navigate to the item where you want the conditional release and select the **Restrictions** tab, or **Availability Dates and Conditions**.
- Click **Create New** to add a new Conditional Release or **Add Existing** to apply a previously created condition.
