Step 2: Arranging the Flowers

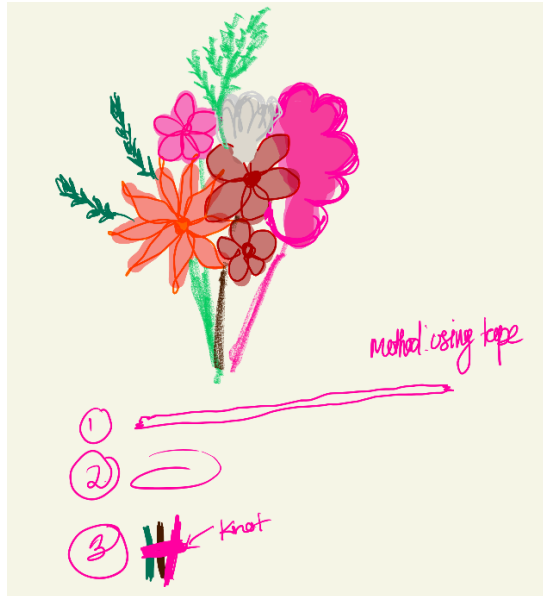

Fluff out the petals to create a fuller appearance for the bouquet. Ensure the flowers are evenly spread out to achieve a balanced look. If you're gifting the bouquet, consider wrapping it in decorative paper to add a professional touch.
