

## MIDI Set up in your DAW

### Arturia Minilab 3 to FL Studio

1. Make sure your Arturia Minilab 3 is registered through the Arturia website:  
<https://www.arturia.com/support/registeryourproduct>
2. Download the Arturia Software Center to access any necessary drivers and updates.
3. Check the required inputs for your MIDI device. For the Arturia Minilab 3, you need a USB-C cable. You may need an adapter depending on what computer you are using.
4. Connect the cable to the MIDI device and your computer.
5. After drivers are installed and the MIDI controller is connected to your computer, open FL Studio.
6. Open the FL Studios Audio settings: Options > Audio settings
7. In the Input/Output settings, click the drop-down menu next to “device”, and select the Mini Lab 3 MIDI controller.
8. Make sure the MIDI Remote control is active by going to: Options > Enable MIDI Remote Control, and make sure it is checked on.
9. You should now be able to use the Minilab 3 with FL Studio.
