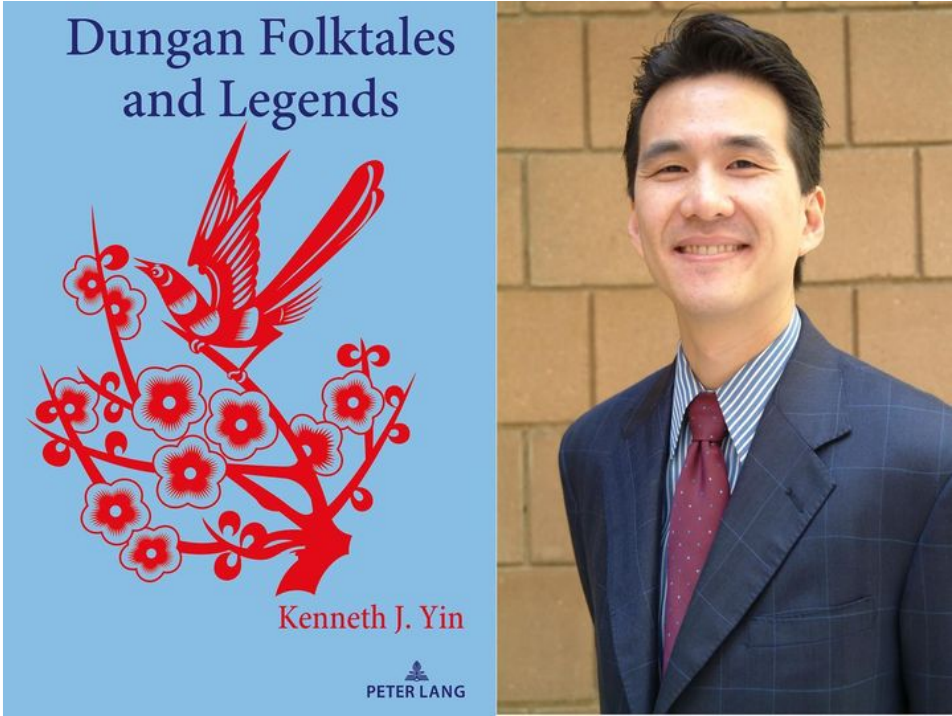


Middlebury Language Schools

Kenneth J. Yin, an alumnus of Middlebury’s Russian and Chinese schools, has published *Dungan Folktales and Legends* (Peter Lang, 2021), the most comprehensive collection of Dungan folk narratives to appear in English. He specializes in the literature and culture of the Dungans, Sinophone Muslims who fled Northwest China for Russian Central Asia after the suppression of the Dungan Revolt (1862–1877) under the Qing dynasty. Dungan oral tradition is a vibrant and fascinating tapestry of Chinese, Islamic, and various Central Asian cultural elements. The book, aimed at general readers and scholars alike, features an introduction to the Dungan tale and seventy-eight folk stories.
