1. Does the author introduce the object in a clear and understandable way?

The author introduces the object in a clear and understandable way. Their first sentence mentions how the iPhone is a device that is used worldwide, then in the same paragraph mentions the process that is done when trying to create an iPhone. In the next paragraph the author goes into depth about who manufactures the iPhone and it's first versions from the mid-2000s, helping the reader understand what the author is writing about and the context that the iPhone is made from a process that has been going on for good amount of time now.

2. Who does the intended audience seem to be? How can you tell?

The intended audience seems to be people want to work for apple or trying to learn about brainstorming and then manufacturing process that goes into making an iPhone. I can tell because the author mentions everything that I had previously stated, they talk about how the iPhone starts off with an idea and then building the hardware, then assembling said parts and finally making sure the final product is up to their standards. Following this the author gives background context about the iPhone, like when the first iPhone came out and even how they continue to improve their manufacturing process year by year.

3. Does the letter offer a comprehensive history of the object, mechanism, or process described?

The letter doesn't offer a comprehensive history of the process described. The only thing that is mentioned about the process of how an iPhone is made is a quick sentence talking about how it starts as an idea, the idea gets made and then tested. In addition, there doesn't seem to be any research done on said process because there aren't any references, just a vague idea on how the iPhone is being produced. The author also doesn't go into depth about the history of the iPhone only briefly mentioning how the first one came out in the mid-2000s.

4. Offer three suggestions for how the writer should proceed in their description.

Three suggestions I would offer the writer are doing more research, going into more detail about the history of an iPhone, and more details overall. Doing more research about the iPhone could be really helpful in giving the reader a better understanding of the process of manufacturing an iPhone like, what were some of the prototypes of the first iPhone, what kind

of steps were done at the planning design, building the hardware and so on. Leading into my next point about how more history of an iPhone needs to be giving, like what was the exact day the iPhone was announce and maybe giving a quick mention on some struggles they had in making the early iPhone. Finally offering more detail overall can help make the reader get understanding on what the author is going to write about, as a reader I get the general idea but beyond that I'm left with questions that I had written in earlier statements.
