

TECHNICAL DESCRIPTION REFLECTION

One of the objectives of the course I focused on while working on this assignment is enhancing strategies for drafting, revising, and editing. To my understanding, this means improving my writing by critically reading my work, identifying my weaknesses, and making significant improvements to my work.

While working on my technical description of a lithium-ion battery, I went through various stages of revision that helped me improve my writing. To begin with, while working on my first draft, I realized that there were various sentences that were lengthy and repetitive, especially while working on sections such as system interaction. For instance, I found that there were various ideas that I repeated, such as "components working together," which made my work less clear.

Another important improvement I made is organization. I made sure the explanation follows a logical order, starting with the parts of the battery and then moving on to how the system works when it is being charged and when it is being discharged. I have also added better transitions to the text to make it easier to read.

Editing has helped me realize the importance of revising my work, making it clearer, better organized, and easier to read by the intended audience.
